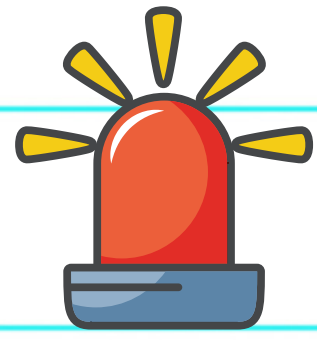

Any student that opens up an exterior door to let anyone in will receive consequence. (OSS)

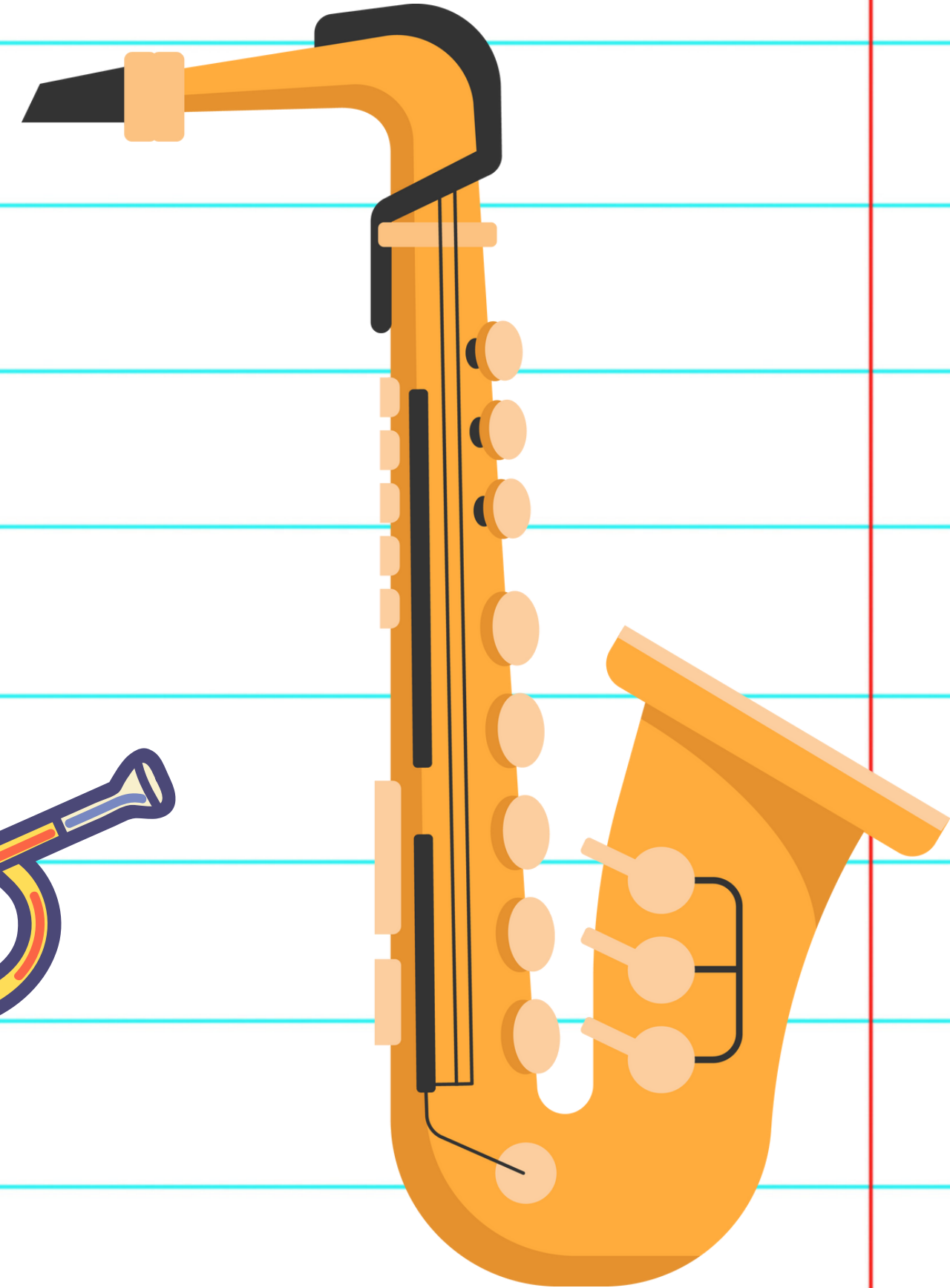
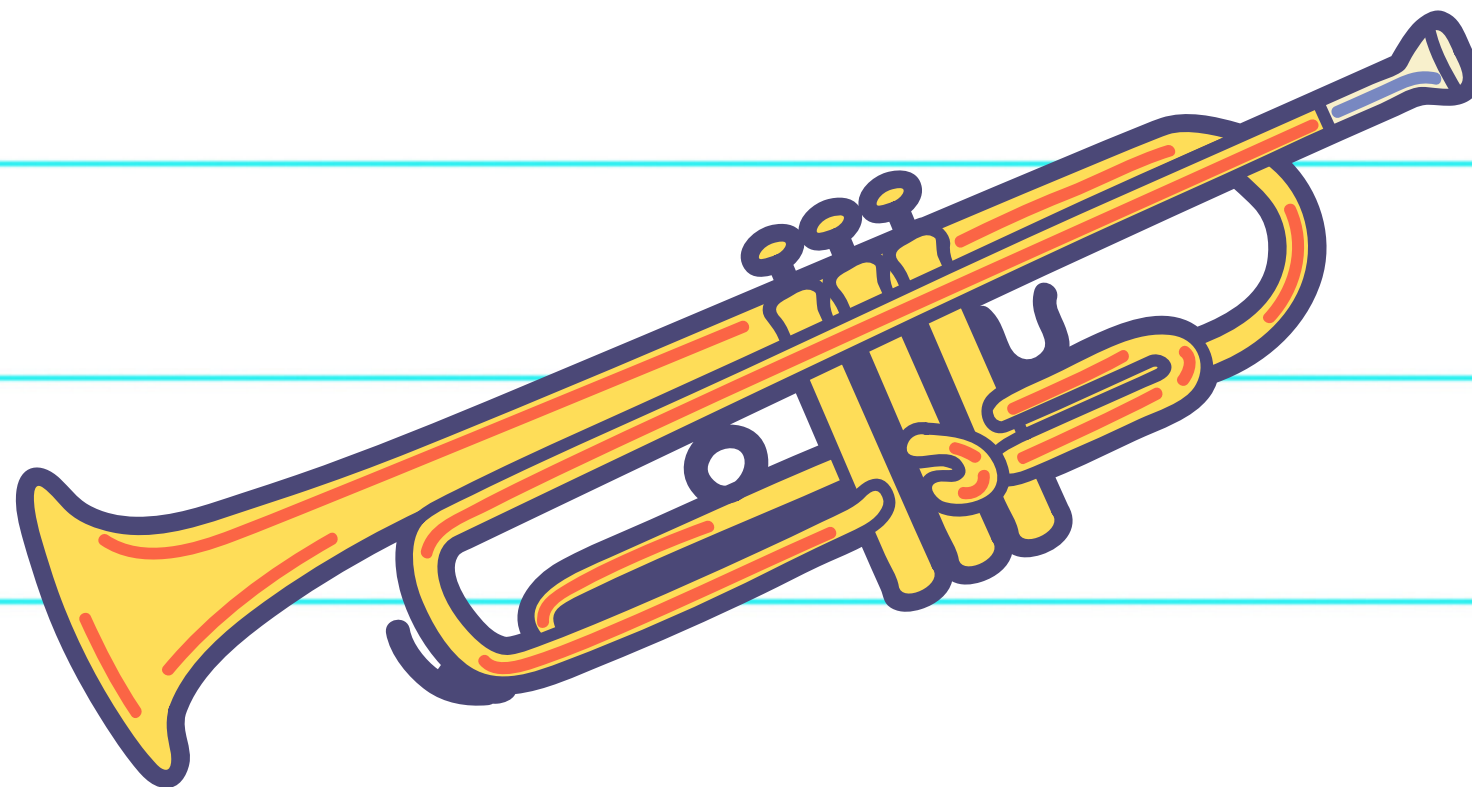

motor transportation.

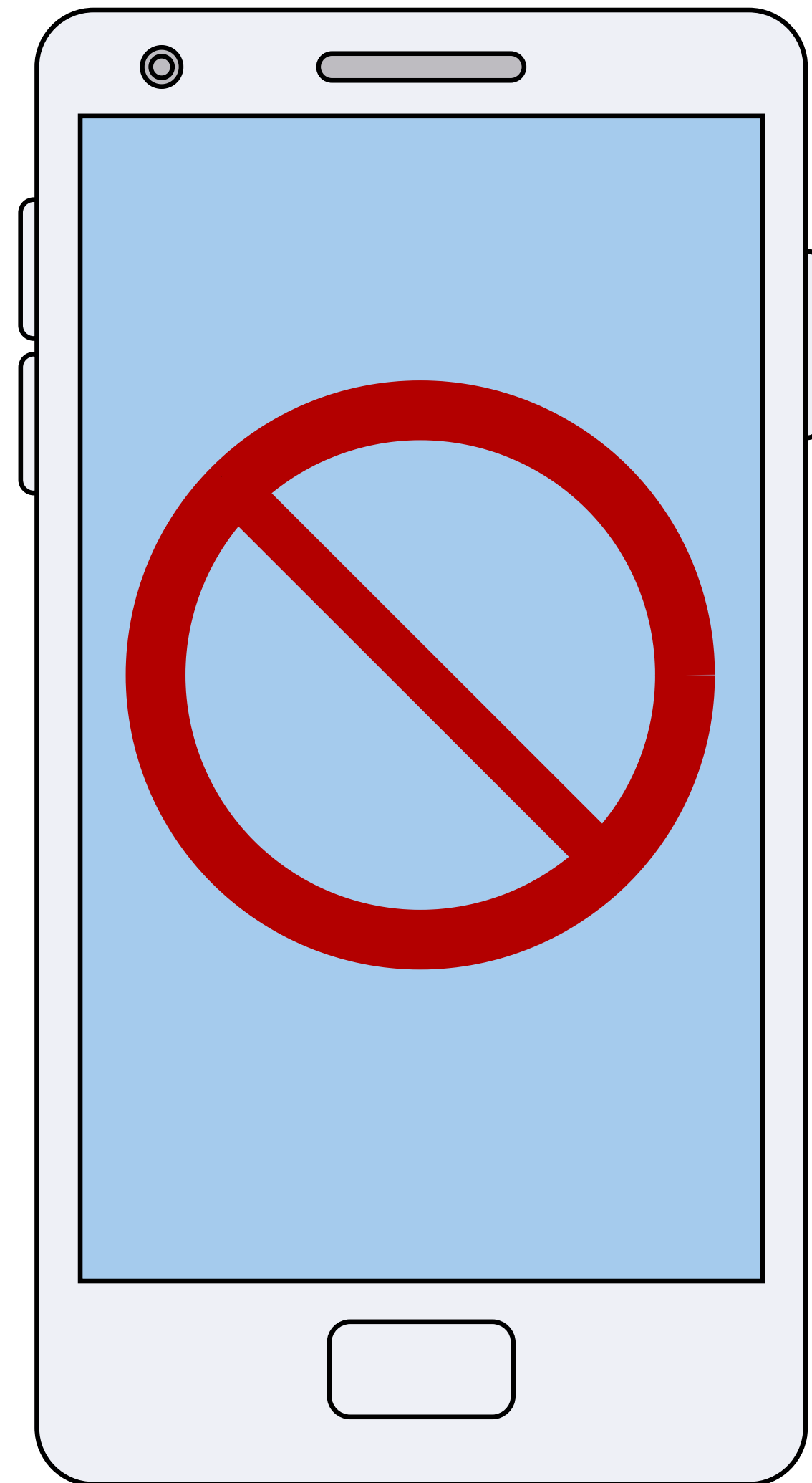


CELL PHONES

PARENT CONTACT WILL BE MADE TO PICK UP THE PHONE.



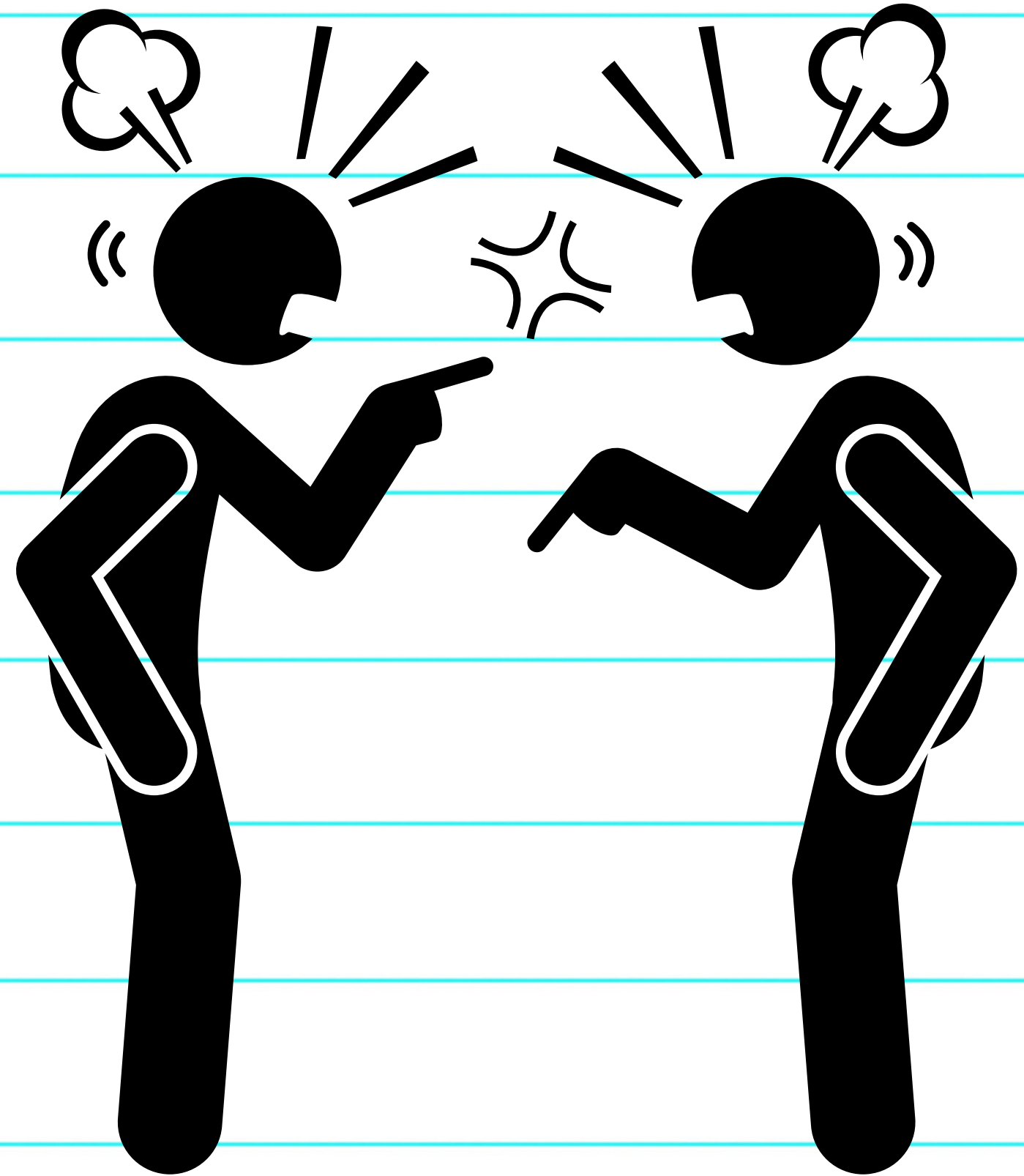
SAFETY CONFLICT

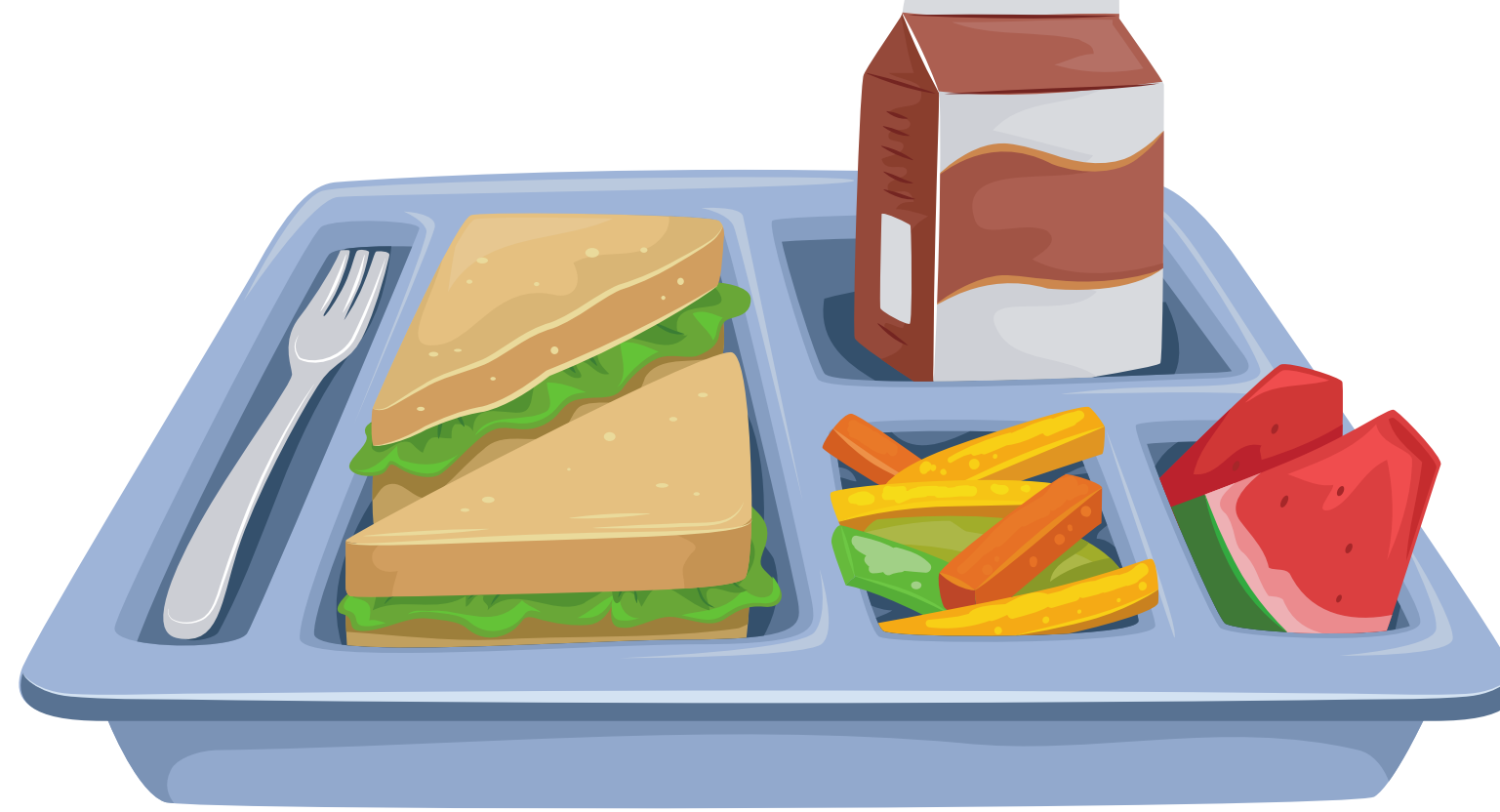
LUNCH EXPECTATIONS

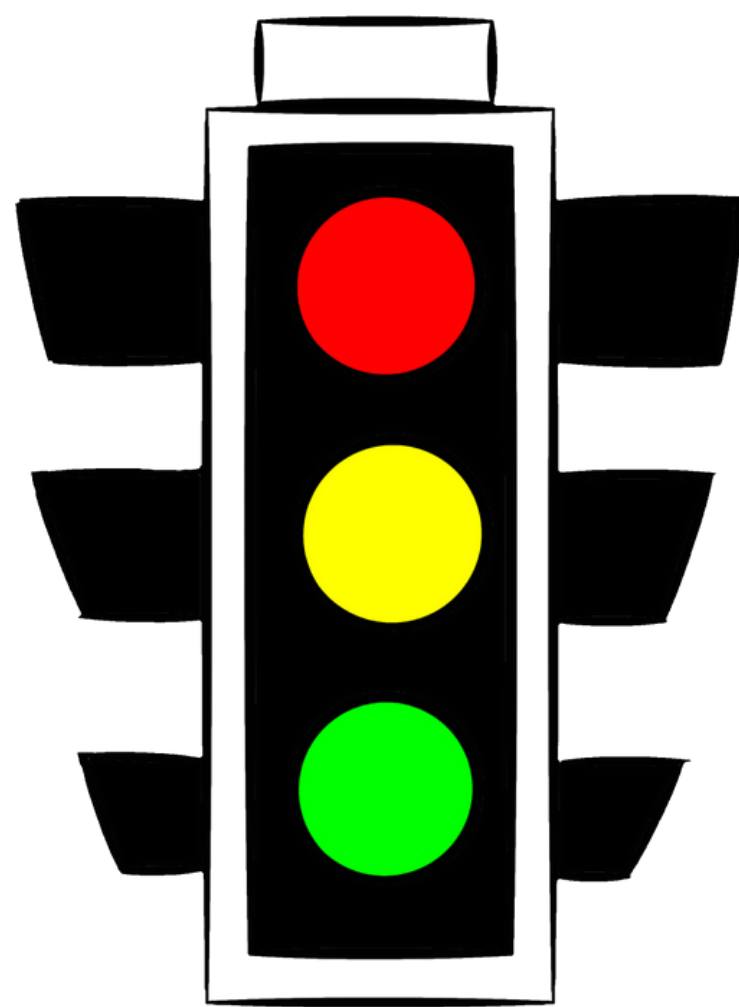

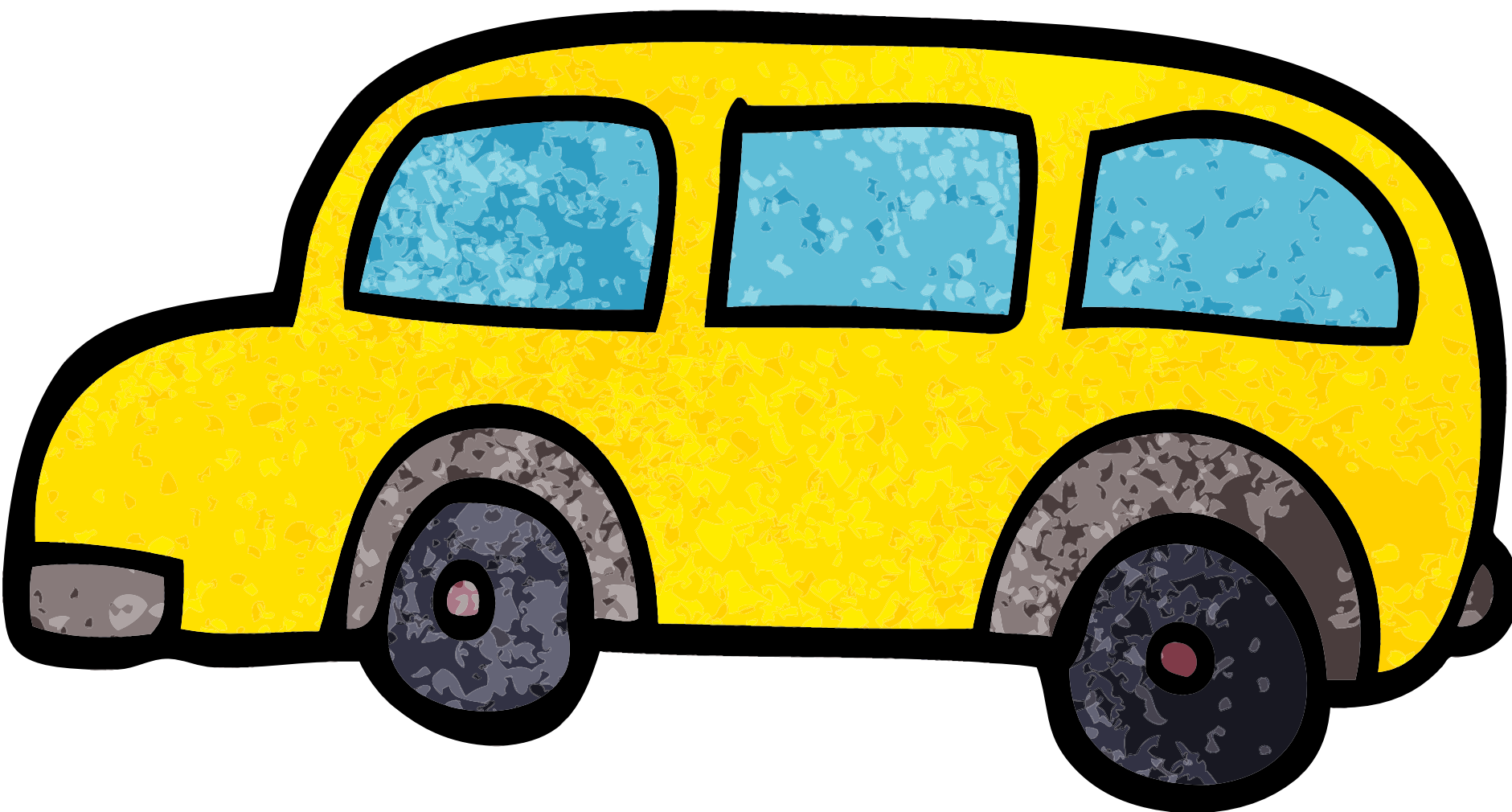

DRESS CODE SWEEPS WILL BEGIN STARTING FRIDAY, JANUARY 5TH, 2024

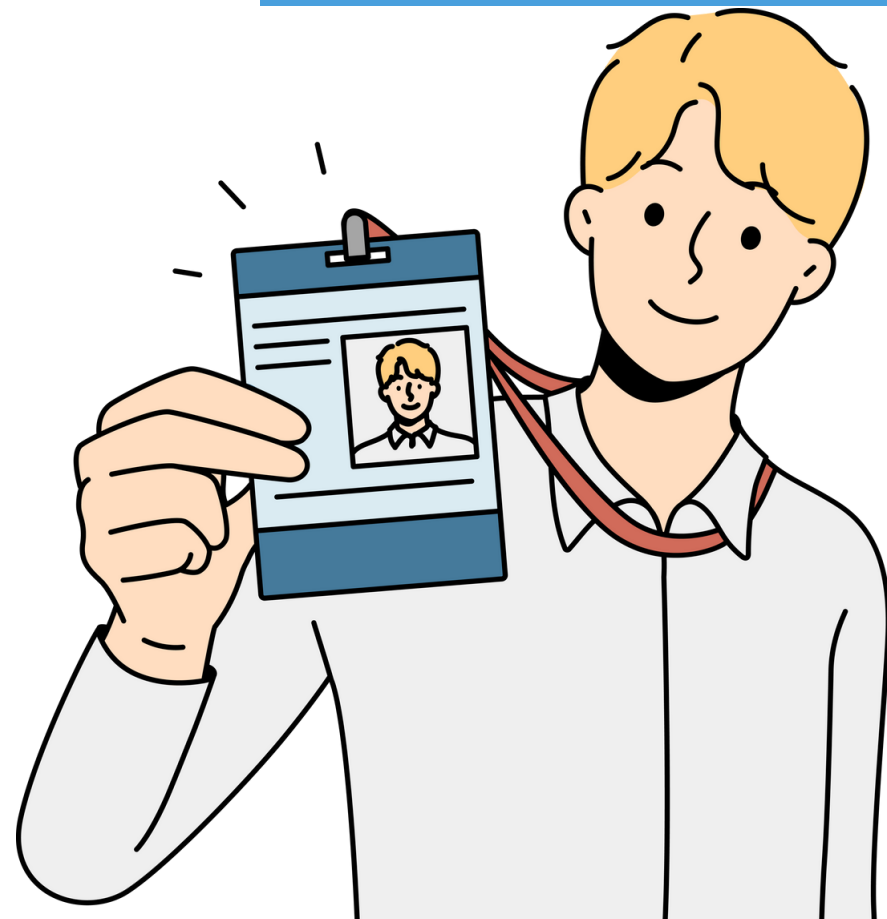

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT IDS

- ID CHECKS OCCUR DAILY AS YOU ENTER THE BUILDING
- TEMPORARY IDS WILL CONTINUE TO BE PROVIDED TO STUDENTS WITHOUT IDS.
(UPON ENTERING THE BUILDING)
- STUDENT MUST ALWAYS HAVE AN ID ON AT ALL TIMES
- CONSEQUENCES FOR FAILURE TO HAVE AN ID WILL BEGIN ON WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 10TH, 2024.

LCISD Secondary Dress Code

No Hoodies on head.

"3 Finger Strap Rule"

ID's Visible on top part of body at all times.

Entire area from armpit to bottom 3-4 inches length must be covered.

Bottoms

3 – 4 inches length in both front and back.

Footwear

No slippers, house shoes, shower shoes
Slides and Crocs are acceptable.

Additional Reminders

- NO sunglasses in buildings
- NO clothing depicting, implying, or advocating illegal or violent conduct, weapons, obscene language, alcohol, tobacco, marijuana, or other illegal or controlled substances.
- NO holes in jeans above the 3 – 4-inch inseam
- NO pajamas
- NO blankets
- NO sports bags or duffle bags



ID Badge /Dress Code Discipline System

<u>1st</u> Violation	Parent Contact/Student will have to get a replacement ID/change to appropriate clothing (Warning)
<u>2nd</u> Violation	Office referral and AP will assign consequences (Lunch Detention)
<u>3rd</u> Violation	Office referral and AP will assign consequences (Afterschool D-Hall)
<u>4th</u> Violation	Office referral and AP will assign consequences (ISS)
<u>5th</u> Violation	Office referral and AP will assign consequence (ONS/Behavior contract)

TARDY PROCESS

Tardy Discipline System

<u>3</u> Tardies	Parent contact/behavior contract
<u>7</u> Tardies	Office referral and AP will assign consequence
<u>10</u> Tardies	Office referral and AP will assign consequence

- When a student reaches **3 tardies**, their parents will get an email and phone call notifying them of their student's actions. Those students will sign a behavior contract.
- When a student reaches **7 tardies**, Skyward will generate an office referral. APs will assign a consequence as appropriate.
- When a student reaches **10 tardies**, Skyward will generate an office referral. APs will assign a consequence as appropriate.

*Tardies reset every 6 weeks.
