



GET YOUR CHILD'S FREE FLU SHOT AT COMMON THREADS DURING OUR WINTER DISTRIBUTION SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 7TH, 2015 FROM 9-1 PM

Children through 18 years of age who meet at least one of the following criteria are eligible to receive VFC vaccine:

- **Medicaid eligible:** A child who is eligible for the Medicaid program. (For the purposes of the VFC program, the terms "Medicaid-eligible" and "Medicaid-enrolled" are equivalent and refer to children who have health insurance covered by a state Medicaid program)
- **Uninsured:** A child who has no health insurance coverage
- **American Indian or Alaska Native:** As defined by the Indian Health Care Improvement Act (25 U.S.C. 1603)
- **Underinsured:** A child who has health insurance, but the coverage does not include vaccines; a child whose insurance covers only selected vaccines (VFCeligible for non-covered vaccines only).
Underinsured children are eligible to receive VFC vaccine only through a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC), or Rural Health Clinic (RHC) or under an approved deputization agreement.
