

CONVERSION OF NON-
NUMERICAL GRADES
FOR TRANSFER
STUDENTS

Per TAC 74.26(a)(2) and the Academic Achievement Record Data Standards, the District will convert any letter grades of students enrolling in the District from out-of-state, out-of-country or from accredited non-public schools accordingly:

<u>Letter Grade</u>	<u>Numerical Equivalent</u>
A	95
B	85
C	77
D	72
F	65

Any grades indicating Satisfactory / Unsatisfactory (or S/U) performance will not be converted to a numerical equivalent. Instead, per the Academic Achievement Record Data Standards, these grades will be converted to Pass / Fail (or P/F).

GPA WEIGHTING OF
CONVERTED GRADES

Every effort will be made to appropriately match grades and courses of students enrolling in the District from out-of-state, out-of-country or from accredited non-public schools according to the weighting categories identified in Board Policy EIC (LOCAL). If it is not clear whether or not a course matches one of the categories defined in EIC (LOCAL), the course weight shall default to the Academic weighting level.
