

VARSITY UIL
ELIGIBILITY FOR
INTRADISTRICT
TRANSFER STUDENTS

Pursuant to LCISD Board Policy FDB; *students who reside in LCISD and have a parent that is a full time employee of the District have the option to transfer to another campus. Transfers that are granted to resident full-time employees must be renewed annually. If the employee terminates employment with the District, the student shall return to the campus for which he or she is zoned at the end of the semester in which employment ends. All transfers are considered on a case-by-case and yearly basis.*

Pursuant to University Interscholastic League Constitution and Contest Rules, Sub-Chapter M, Section 403 (f)(4); a student who has an option to attend more than one high school within a school district, rather than being assigned to a school according to attendance zones, is eligible at the school first selected if he or she transfers at their first opportunity. If a student subsequently transfers to another school, the student is not eligible for varsity athletic competition until he or she has been in and regularly attended that school for at least the previous calendar year.

Lamar Consolidated ISD deems the student's first opportunity for transfer to be their 9th grade year or the year following 9th grade in which they became eligible for the employee based transfer.

Any student athlete who elects to transfer to a campus other than their home campus must complete a Previous Athletic Participation Form for submission to the appropriate DEC prior to becoming varsity eligible.

LCISD students who exercise their transfer option at first opportunity, and meet all other eligibility requirements as outlined by the UIL, will be eligible for Varsity contests during the first year of their transfer.

Subsequently, any athlete who revokes their transfer for any reason after their first date of enrollment at their selected campus will be deemed ineligible for one calendar year from their date of enrollment at their newly elected campus.
