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Dear LCISD Parents:

While many high school students are confident about their futures and their career choices, many others may need help and support as they make these important life transitions. For many young adults, the prospect of embarking on a career, at times, can be daunting. Since students probably are aware of the current realities of the world of work, they may question what the future holds for them. We emphasize the importance of planning and decision making, believing that these skills will serve students not only in realizing their post-high school goals and subsequent career transitions, but also in other areas of their lives.

The ASVAB Career Exploration Program is a comprehensive career exploration and planning program that includes a multiple aptitude test battery, an interest inventory, and various career planning tools designed to help students explore the world of work. The Program provides tools, including the test battery and an interest inventory, that was developed to help high school and post-secondary students across the nation, learn more about career exploration and planning. Results of the aptitude test and the interest inventory enable students to evaluate their skills, estimate performance in academic and vocational endeavors, and identify potentially satisfying careers. These results are integrated with work values to help students identify and prioritize possible career choices. Students are encouraged to consider their own work-related values and other important personal preferences as they explore the world of work and learn career exploration skills that will benefit them throughout their work lives.

This test is used to measure a student's aptitude and to show a student, his/her academic strengths and weaknesses. The ASVAB Test allows students to see if their Math, Science, and Verbal skills scores, are where they should be, for the careers that they are thinking about pursuing. This is critical information for all students who are trying to make realistic decisions about their future career paths. Taking the ASVAB test and participating in our ASVAB Career Exploration Program, does not obligate a high school student to join any branch of the military. The scores will not be disbursed to any military branch UNLESS the student or parent so chooses so by signing a request of release form when meeting with a military recruiter.

LCISD high schools will be offering the ASVAB test on December 1st for students in 10th-12th grades. Scores for students in the 11th and 12th grade are good for up to two years and can be used as part of their military enlistment process if they choose to submit them to the recruiter.
