PLAYGROUND

Playscapes

- Feet first down slides
- We only go DOWN slides
- Rubber chips stay on the ground
- Take turns on monkey bars and other climbing areas
- One at a time on rockers/spinners
- Sit on a seat when using the teeter totters.
- Watch for others before swinging on the bars
- Be safe, respectful and responsible

Turf

- Great place to run and do acrobatics
- One or two hand touch for games like tag and football (NO tackling, climbing on people, or pulling on clothing)
- Soccer has to be on the turf
- Follow the rules of the game; when a problem arises, ask an adult if help is needed.
- Be safe, respectful and responsible

PLAYGROUND

Blacktop

- Great place for basketball, jumprope, catch, walking around, or running games
- Follow the rules of the game; when a problem arises, ask an adult if help is needed.
- Stay away from windows (no peeking); keep playground balls away from windows.
- Be safe, respectful and responsible.

SNOW

- You must have boots on to walk on the snow; shoes stay on the shoveled area.
- For Kindergarten-2nd grade snow pants must be worn to go down snowy slides and sit/lay/crawl in the snow.
- We share the snow; if you build something, it will probably be gone or changed the next time you come out.
- Snow is for playing and building NOT throwing.
- Brush extra snow off of your snow clothes and boots BEFORE going inside.

PLAYGROUND EXPECTATIONS

How to Play Tag

1. Decide who is "it".
2. The person "it" will chase the other players, trying to tag them.
3. When you are touched by the person who is "it", you immediately become "it".
4. Set boundaries so that the "not-it" players can't run too far.
5. Discuss if there is a "safe zone" of where someone can't be tagged and determine how long they can stand there.
6. 5 second head start before start
7. The game usually continues until everyone decides to stop.

Soccer Guidelines

1. No Hands.
2. Kick-off is placed in the center of the field. (Players on own half)- Ball can be passed back.
3. After a team scores a goal, the kick-off is taken by the other team.
4. Throw-in occurs when the ball goes out of bounds, opposing team gets the ball. (use 2 hands)
5. Corner kick/goal kick is taken when the ball leaves the field across a goal line.
6. As long as the ball is in field, the game is in play.

HALLWAYS



- Line up at voice level zero and practice walking to art/music
 - Artwork on the wall is to be appreciated with your eyes and not your hands.
 - Always walk to be safe. Stay to the right, single file, especially on the stairs.
 - Wait on the specials line patiently and quietly until your specials teacher welcomes you
- Walk back to their lockers and practice lining up at voice level zero and walking to PE
 - Wait quietly in front of a locker for the PE teacher to welcome you in
- If students do not follow the expectations, please go back and make them do it again until the expectations are met.

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BATHROOM & WATER FOUNTAIN

Water fountain - “1,2,3 is enough for me”

Bathroom

- Respect the privacy of others
- 1 or 2 pumps of soap
- “1,2,3 rip” for paper towel (for the 3-5 bathrooms, 2 swipes)
- Make sure your paper towel goes INTO the garbage can before you leave

CAFETERIA

- Wait patiently in line with hands/feet to self when you enter the lunch room
- Calmly take a tray
- Wait patiently in line with hands/feet to self
- Say please/thank you as appropriate while being served
- Enter lunch code
- Sit where expected to sit and stay there until dismissed
- Raise hand and ask permission if you need anything, including dumping your tray
- If your teacher is not there yet, return to your seat after dumping your tray.
- You may not share food
- Voice level 1 or 2
- Hands and feet to self
- When you see your teacher, walk quietly to line up

LOST AND FOUND/OFFICE

Lost and Found

- A “lost” item can be anything that is not put back into or hanging on a locker; if you do not put their things in their locker, they may end up here.
- If you find something and do not know who it belongs to, you may put it in lost and found.
- If you are missing something of yours, you may look for it here before or after school.
- You should NOT be looking for anything here if you have not lost anything. This is NOT a place to just borrow or take items.

Office

- Stand where Ms. Sue or Ms. Britney can see you; never go behind the desk.
- Quietly wait for them to welcome you and ask you what you need; do NOT interrupt them.
- Calmly tell them why you are there.
- Follow the directions they give you.
- Return directly to class when they tell you to.

SOARING HAWK TICKETS

- Each adult in the building may give out soaring hawk tickets to students who are demonstrating safe, respectful, and responsible behaviors.
- Each classroom will be given a 100 chart for the teacher to color in as they give out tickets. Each classroom should choose a classroom celebration with their teacher when 100 are received (i.e extra recess minutes, pj day, special snack, board game time, etc.).
- When the school receives 900 total, there will be an all school celebration planned.

ARRIVAL

- Respectfully greet the door holder as you enter
- When you enter school, you go straight to the lunch room. You either get in line to get breakfast or go sit at the appropriate table.
- Voices are level 1
- Get in line; wait patiently
- Choose your milk, breakfast bag, and wait to make other breakfast choice
- Raise your hand and ask permission to take food from the share table; only take it if you are hungry and will eat it.
- Unopened food may be taken out of the bag and put at the share table when you are dismissed or with adult permission.
- When the bell rings, make sure your trash is all cleaned up and in the trash can. Grades 3/4/5 exits through the side door and K/1/2 exits through the main door.
- Quietly walk to your locker. Take off your winter gear and place inside your locker along with your backpack. Bring into class all needed supplies.
- Quickly and quietly head to class for morning jobs.

COMMON SPACE

- Enter quietly
- Find a seat
- The space is used for small groups/presentations/Independent work
- Listen to whomever is leading your group
- Leave the space as clean or cleaner than you found it

SMART TRACK

- Wait patiently for your turn
- Move through the track safely, respectfully, and responsibly
- Start at the feet by the rubics cubes
- Follow directions as you move through the track
- Smart tracks are to be utilized by classrooms during bathroom breaks, movement breaks, individual breaks with students who can be trusted to be sent there independently or sent with an adult, etc.

APPROPRIATE LANGUAGE

- How you speak at school might be different than how you speak outside of school
- Adults need to use appropriate language in their jobs
- **At Hamilton Elementary School, we expect all students and staff to be respectful, responsible, and safe with their language.**
- What does that mean?
 - **Be Respectful**→ Use everyone's preferred names & pronouns.
 - **Be Responsible**→ Use your manners: Please, thank you, excuse me.
 - **Be Safe**→ Use appropriate volume. Use appropriate language that is not hurtful to others.



SCHOOL IPADS GRADES 3-5

- iPads should be checked in at the end of the day
- When walking in the hallway → iPad is closed, music is turned *OFF*.
- Before charging iPads at the end of the day - Double Click the Home button and swipe out of ALL apps.
- iPads are monitored by school administration → Search safely. Any inappropriate searches are sent to administrators.
- iPads are SCHOOL property

REMEMBER: iPads are a Tool, Not a Toy

CLASSROOM BEHAVIORS

- Focus on not disrupting the learning of others.
- Stay in your assigned seat during classes
- Stay focused on the teacher and the lesson.
- Use class time to work hard on your assignments!
