HONOR POINTS

The following is a brief description on how we distinguish students who take a more rigorous curriculum by taking Honors/A.P. Courses.

Year long Honor courses receive 5 HP points while semester long courses receive 2.5 Honors points. Upon graduation, we would report GPA to the colleges as usual, but rank students according to HP instead. Student A could have a HP of 50, while student B, with the same GPA could have a HP of 42.
