
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Important News

Nutrition Information

<u>ALL</u> students enrolled at Northside Elementary are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **NO CHARGE** each day of the 2024-2025 school year.

IMPORTANT: It is still necessary for each family to complete a Free/Reduced Application so that if you have children in other schools in our district they may still be evaluated to receive free/reduced meals at those schools. Completing the Free/Reduced Application is also necessary for Northside Elementary/Coulee Montessori to qualify for other funding that will enhance educational opportunities for students. In addition, completing the form assures that your child will be evaluated for free/reduced status if you should move to another district school sometime during the year. The Free/Reduced Application will be mailed to your home mid-summer. Families may also complete this application online.



SUMMER MEALS

Summer meals will start on June 10th at Logan Middle and Logan High. Breakfast will be served from 7:30 – 8:30AM and lunch will be served from 11:30 – 12:30PM daily Monday through Friday. Meal service will end on August 14th. Meals are free for those under 18.

Medications

- Questions about medication procedures and health concerns can be directed to Northside/CM's Health Assistant, Alexis Klatt.
- Written, signed permission must be on file at school before any medication can be administered to a child.
- Prescription drugs require a doctor's and parent's signature; nonprescription drugs require a parent signature. Forms are available from the health office, on the School District's website,

www.lacrosseschools.org, and at most clinics in the area.

- All medication must be in its original container with the dosage clearly marked.
- ✓ All medication will be administered and recorded in the health office.
- Our School District nurse is Shelley Johnson. Her schedule at Northside/CM is 7:45PM - 3:15PM, Monday through Friday.

Remember, if your child has a fever of 100 degrees or greater or has vomited/diarrhea within the last 24 hours, he/she should stay home from school. Do not forget to call the school office at 789-7970 by 9:00AM to let us know your child will not be in school.

School pictures will be Thursday, September 19th! Order forms will be sent home two weeks prior to pictures. Please make sure that you have the order form filled out and the exact amount inside. We are not able to make change for parents/guardians. You also have the option to pay for pictures online!



Student

The school district does not carry student medical insurance or student accident insurance. As a convenience, student medical coverage is offered through Student Assurance, Inc. Please stop by the office and pick up the forms to fill out.

IMPORTANT: If a coat, backpack, cell phone, clothing, or any other personal items are lost or stolen, the district will not be responsible for recovery or repayment for these items. We do **not** have insurance coverage for the personal belongings of our students. Students are asked not to bring personal items to school.

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What time should my child arrive at school?

Playground supervision begins at 7:45AM. Please do not drop your child off before 7:45AM unless your child is enrolled in the YMCA Surround Care program. NOTE: Y Care does not begin until September 3rd. Students will play on the playground until 8:00AM. The bell to enter the building rings at 8:00AM. This bell brings students in to have breakfast. The official day begins at 8:15AM. All outside doors are locked at 8:15AM. If your child arrives late (after 8:15AM), please bring them to the main office doors to enter the building and ensure they enter safely before you leave. All late students are required to stop in the office for a "Pass to Class" - if the teacher has marked them absent, the "Pass to Class" lets the teacher know the student has checked in at the office. Breakfast is served from 8:00 - 815AM.

In case of inclement weather, the children will enter the building after 7:45AM and go to the gym for supervised activities until 8:00AM. We DO NOT open our doors before 7:45AM even on bad weather days. Please keep this in mind on cold/rainy/snowy days.

IMPORTANT: Children are not allowed in the building prior to 7:45AM. We also ask that they not be dropped off before that as there is no adult supervision outside prior to 7:45AM. If you need care before 7:45AM, please enroll in the YMCA Surround Care Program.

After School Options for Families

- ★ The Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater La Crosse will continue to offer after school activities & programs in Academics, Character & Leadership, and Healthy Lifestyles. More detailed information regarding the Boys & Girls Club will be sent home later. If your child is not a current member, parents should go online or stop by the Boys & Girls Club for a membership form (608) 782-3926.
- ★ YMCA Surround Care: The YMCA of La Crosse will provide affordable quality childcare and academic programming after school at the Northside/Coulee Montessori Campus beginning September 3rd ^t. All children in grades K-5 will be accepted. No child will be turned away due to financial need. This program will take place between 2:55pm and 6:00pm Monday thru Friday. Students will participate in a combination of recreational activities, homework help, academic enrichment, academic tutoring, wellness education and arts and crafts as appropriate for each child. Parents can contact the YMCA of La Crosse at 608-782-9622, Ext. 275 for more information.

Student Pick-Up and Drop-Off

★ For the safety of ALL children at Northside Elementary/Coulee Montessori, please be reminded that parking directly in front of the school on Kane Street and Charles Street from 7:30AM to 4:30PM on school days by the playground is illegal. The street is clearly marked with road signs for "no parking during school days" and "no stopping or standing during school days". This regulation is in effect for the safety of ALL children before and after school.

★ Please help us keep traffic controlled by following the parking regulations and crossing with the staff supervision, crossing guards, and in the crosswalks.

★ Please <u>do not park in the staff parking lot</u> to drop off <u>before school</u> (7:45 – 8:15AM) or to pick up students <u>after school (2:45 – 3:15PM)</u>.

Child Absences/Tardiness/ Leaving Early/Vacations

- Parents/guardians are asked to please call school at 789-7970 before 9:00AM if your child is ill or has an appointment. Your child will also be marked tardy if they are not in their classroom by 8:15AM. We want to make sure that everyone arrives safely and on time!
- Students leaving during regular school hours must be picked up in the office and a parent/guardian/emergency contact will need to sign them out. We will only release your child to you or those people you have designated as "Emergency Contacts". Leaving prior to 1:00PM is considered a half day absence. Parents should communicate with their child's teacher about early pick-ups, when possible.
- For planned absences (vacations, special events, etc.) please fill out the <u>Excused Absence Request</u> form we have located in the office and return it to school at least 2 days before the absence. State law 118.15(3)(c) states that a child may not be excused for more than 10 days in a school year. Please keep this in consideration when planning absences for your child, including medical appointments.

All visitors/volunteers must stop in the office to sign in. You will need to bring your ID/Driver's License with you.

Please plan and fill out a Volunteer Service Application at the beginning of the year to ensure that you are approved when your child has a field trip you want to attend. You can apply on the district website.

Processing an application can take up to 14 days. Applicants will receive an e-mail verification upon approval.




