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
Digital Link and Credentials


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Dashboard

Click on the activities in the modules or use the navigation arrows at the bottom of each activity's page to navigate through the course.






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Locating the Pacing Guide

Year One

Virtual Needs Assessment	This initial call brings together key stakeholders to meet with the assigned LLS support team, review the proposed implementation plan, establish enrollment numbers, and introduce your Client Success Specialist.
Integration	Partners access the Lincoln Learning products before training begins, allowing attendees to interact with the applications during the sessions. Our IT team ensures the functionality of the curriculum by working alongside your technical team.
Initial Training Sessions	Scheduled prior to the start of the school year, Initial Training involves understanding best-use practices for the curriculum within the learning management system through step-by-step and scenario-based instruction.
