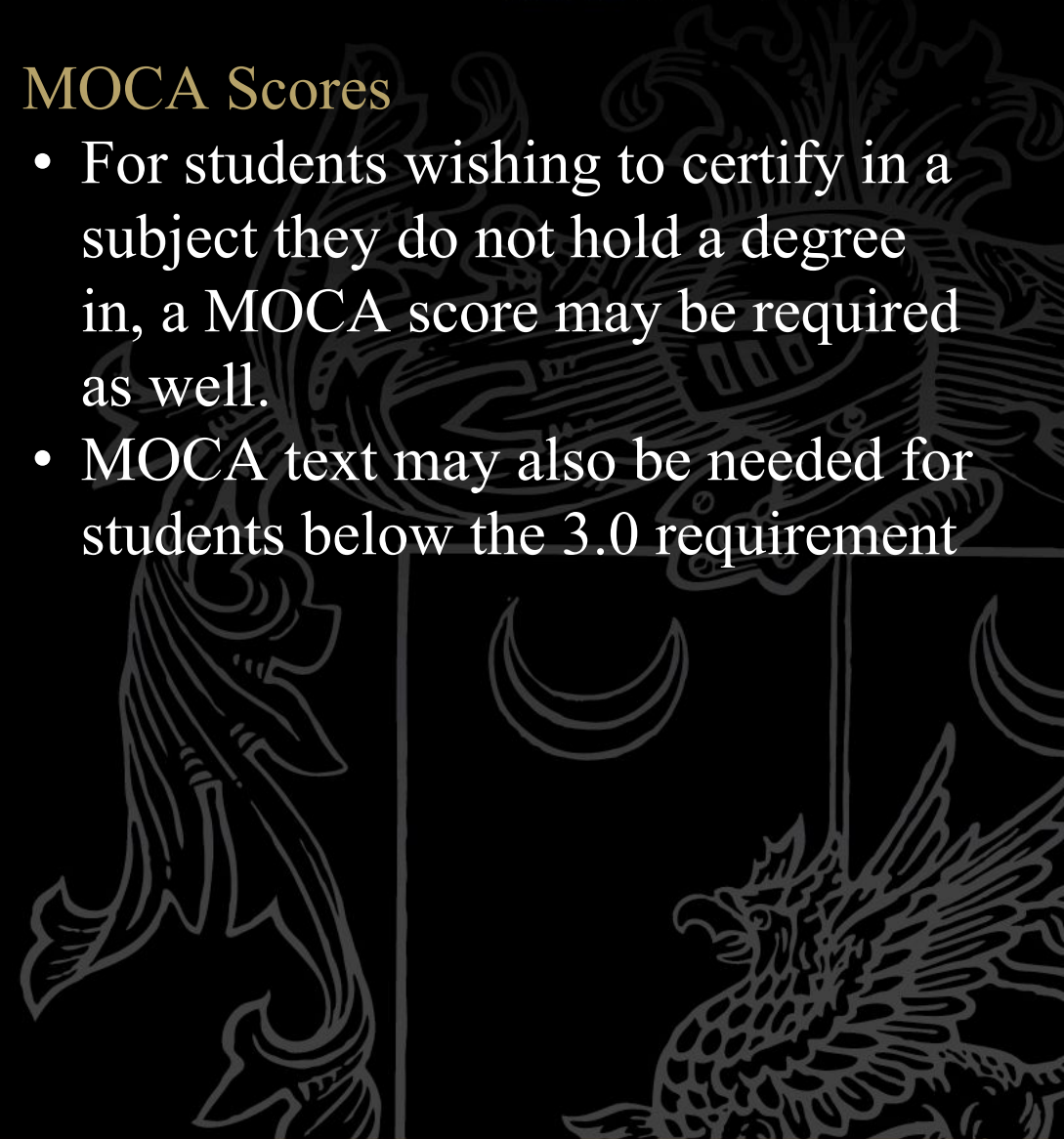
- Transcripts from all institutions of Higher Learning Earned
 - DESE requires a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or more for admittance to the Master of Arts in Teaching program.
- Resume (Only required for Master of Arts in Teaching)

Below 3.0 Cumulative GPA?

- 2 Letters of Recommendation
- Personal Statement Essay
 - These will be added to the application after you have applied by your enrollment representative

MOCA Scores

- For students wishing to certify in a subject they do not hold a degree in, a MOCA score may be required as well.
- MOCA text may also be needed for students below the 3.0 requirement



Cost:

- Undergraduate
 - \$663 Per Credit Hour
- Graduate
 - \$551 Per Credit Hour

Partnered School Districts and Discounts:

- Graduate Students employed with a university partnered school will receive 20% off per credit hour.
- Graduate teaching certification coursework will receive \$60 off per credit hour. (*Note: This is not in addition to the 20% off for university partnered schools.*)
