 use these throughout the entire year, and we go through them

- All sizes of Ziplock baggies—We use these for many activities and for supplies through out the year. We appreciate any sizes!
- Other needs-Throughout the year, we will send out "wish lists" to let parents know any additional supplies we are in need of. Kleenex and Clorox wipes are always appreciated.
