#### YELLOW TICKETS


Any adult working in our school can give out a ticket. When you earn a ticket, then you have demonstrated exemplary behavior, which means:

Step 1: Make sure your <u>first</u> and <u>last</u> name is written on - the back.




Step 3: Put your ticket in your grade level box.

When a specific amount of tickets are earned by a student, that student will be recognized for their effort.
