You may use home computers, tablets, or cell phones log onto: Google Classroom. Here are some pictures and directions to get onto the sites we will be using:


a. Log onto the Lincoln Elementary web page and click on *Lincoln Online Learning* 




b. Watch the little video from Principal McKell then click on the big-blue 3.




c. Click on Symbaloo just below "Here are some links you will be using"



d. In one of the turquoise squares is a green chalk board outlined in yellow. Click here.




e. This is the screen where you choose which class you will be working in today.

I have set up 2 separate classes on Google Classroom. One is green entitled Mrs. Stock 2020. In this class you will find several categories:

- Reading Log this is the reading that students have been doing all year for homework. After they read for 20 minutes, have them write 1 sentence **about** what they read in their *white notebook*. I don't want the title or a sentence copied from the book; have them close the book they were reading and write one sentence using facts or events from the story.
- Reading Street This is the purple book I sent home. There is also a packet of papers entitled, <u>Jalapeno Bagles</u>. The first day, just read the story on page 296. This story can also be read to them by clicking on the link below the assignment in Google Classroom
- 3. Writing There is a packet entitled <u>3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Writing Prompt</u> from the papers you collected from Llincoln. The instructions are written on the 1<sup>st</sup> page and they will also be on Google Classroom day by day.
- 4. Social Studies and Science will also be on there soon.

Assignments are posted daily.

1. There are the pages from the workbook that have videos of me showing how to do some problems. PLEASE if you have questions or problems contact me! I am working from 8:40-4:05 every school day.

- 2. I sent home some papers to practice multiplication problems. Put them in the page protector and use a white-board marker so you can do the pages over and over.
- 3. After you click the big-blue 3, there is a list entitled "Here are some links you will be using:" You can click on Symaloo and click on the box for Think Central or you can click on GoMath and it will take you to the site where students can see videos and take small quizzes so I can see their progress. The quizzes have an option where you can see the problem worked out for you. Explore the buttons to the side of the page where the quiz is.

As I become more proficient with these programs, I will be able to include more activities. As I said earlier, let me know how things are going and what I can do to individually help you and your child.
