Phonics

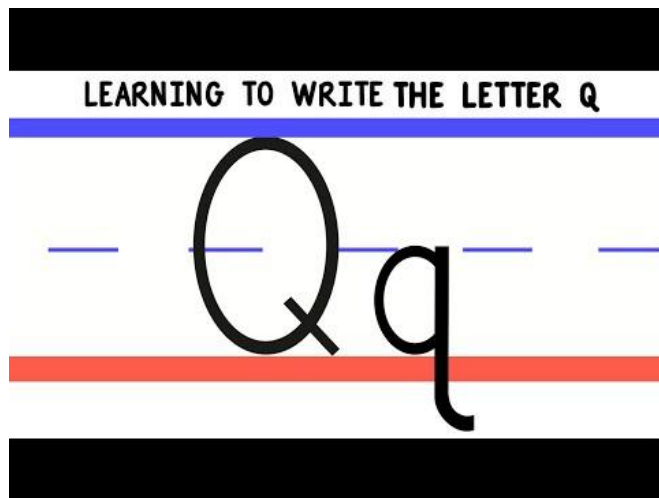

Alphabet Activity

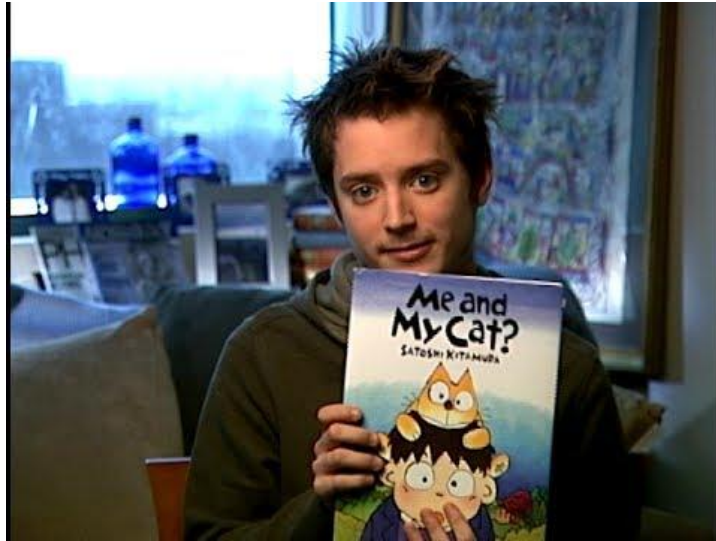
