Phonics Practice

We are working on letter Q. Watch this video about Letter Q.



Alphabet Activity

Put all of your letter tiles into a pot. Draw a big circle on a plain white piece of paper (bowl). Stir the letters in the pot with a spoon while saying the following chant:

Bibbity, bobbity, brew!
Let's make an alphabet stew!
Pull a letter from the pot
And say the letter and sound that you got!

Have your child pull each letter from the pot, say the name and sound of each letter, and write the capital and lowercase letter in their bowl (circle on their paper). It should look like alphabet soup! Then have them circle all of the vowels (a,e,i,o,u).

Phonics

Today we are going to practice sounding out words and writing them. Use your fingers to sound out the words and then write them in your writing journal.

Moveable Alphabet

Give your child several letters from their letter tiles, including a vowel. Let your child manipulate the letters to make words and list them on a dry-erase board, or in their writing journal. See how many words they can list.
