You are going to say part of a word to your child. Your child will add a long vowel sound to the **beginning** to make a whole word. For example: You will say /j/. Have your child add /ā/ at the beginning. Put it together and you will have “age.”

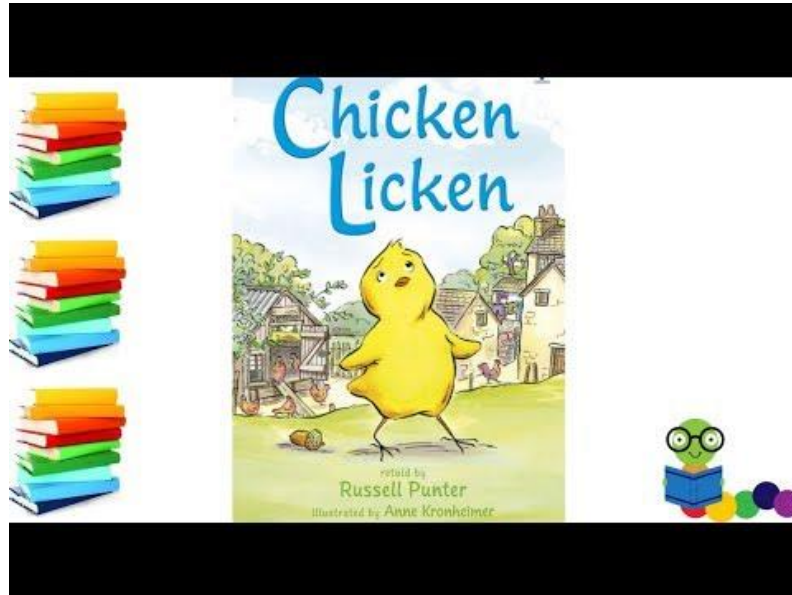

2. Who are some of the animals that Chicken Licken meets?
3. Can the sky really fall? Why were the animals upset at Chicken Licken at the end of the book?

Writing Time

When a hen (a female chicken) lays an egg, she will sit on the egg between 19-21 days. If there is not a hen to sit on the egg, then the egg needs to be put in an incubator (a device that keeps the eggs a certain temperature) to keep it warm. During the 19-21 days the chick grows inside of the egg. In the video below, you will see the egg on the right hand side rock. The chick is getting bigger and is getting ready to come out.

In your writing journal, write and draw a picture about the following:

Do you think the chick is excited to come out? Why or why not?
