# Alphabet Review

## What's Missing?

Write 5 letters on a dry-erase board. Have your child look at the letters and say the name and sounds. Turn it around so the child cannot see them and erase one letter. Show the board to the child again and he/she must say what letter is missing. Play at least 3 times. For a variation, you could take more letters away.

# Phonics

You are going to say some sounds to your child. They are going to say a long vowel sound after your sound that will make it into a word. For ex: you say /s/ and your child could add the /ā/ sound to then blend the word and make “say”. If they add the /e/ sound, then it would be “see” etc.

/st/

/m/

/l/

/b/

/w/

Today we are going to read My Pal Bo. Let's practice some words that we will see in the book today. Please have someone say these words to you. Please sound them out and write these words on a piece of paper or in a writing journal.

my	pal	best
what	swim	pond
love	said	me

Read My Pal Bo. It is decodable reader number 11 (black and white books).

# Sight Word Practice

## Guess the Word

We are going to start with the word “what”. Draw 4 lines on the magnetic wipe-off board \_\_\_\_ (or on a paper) and place 10 letter tiles (including the letters for “what”) at the top. Ask your child to choose a sound. If that sound is in the word, place it on the correct line. If the sound is not in the word, take an object (points) away. The child tries to figure out the word before he/she loses all of his/her points or objects! Continue to play with the other three words below.
