Alphabet Activity

We are going to practice saying the alphabet as we roll a ball. You say the letter A, and then roll a ball to your child and he/she says the letter B. The child rolls the ball back to you and you say C. Roll the ball back to your child and he/she says D. Continue this way until the alphabet is finished. You can involve others in your family if you wish.

Phonics

Today we are going to say beginning, middle and final sounds of words. You say the first word, then have your child tell you the beginning sound, the middle sound, then the ending or final sound of the word. Use the words in the table below.

hat	tag	tap	nap
pan	man	map	mop
lip	pin	fan	fin

More Phonics

Today we are going to learn the long sound for the letter /ē/. Please listen to the following video. Tell a family member what two sounds the letter /e/ makes when the video is finished. (/ē/ as in eel and /e/ as in elephant)
