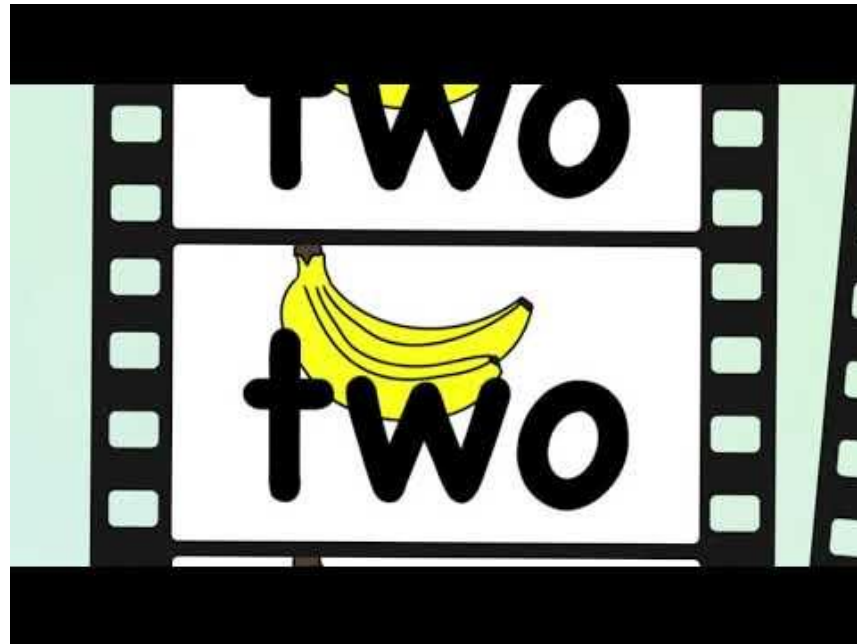

Today we are practicing the sight word “two”. Please print and do the following worksheet.

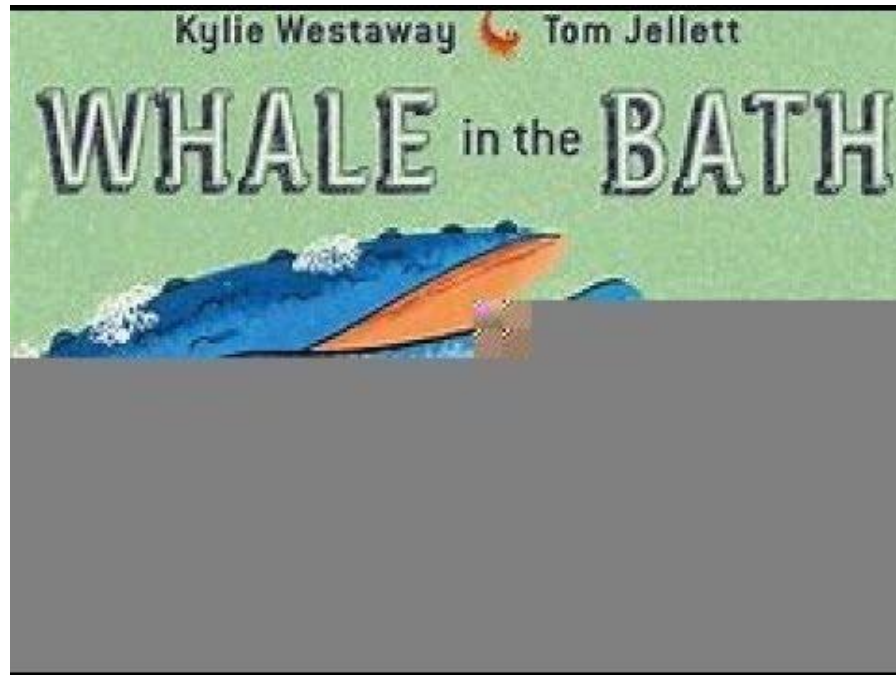

# Writing Time

Go to the pebble go website. Click on animals, and then mammals. Choose whales and other water mammals. Go through at least two animals. Make sure you click on all the tabs of each animal. When you are finished, write and draw two things you have learned about one of the water mammals.

# Math Time

We are now done with Go Math (the math we have been doing online and the worksheets.) For the rest of the year, we will be reviewing the concepts that we have learned. **Today you will pick up a packet from the school that has all of the math pages that we are going to do. The date that you will do the papers is in the upper right hand corner.**

Today we will do the first two pages. They are “**Caterpillar Counting**” and “**Count the Bugs**”. On Caterpillar counting you are going to write in the missing number. Notice that it starts with 9 and not 1. Think, what comes after 9.

On Count the Bugs, you will count the bugs and write the number on the jar. Make sure you cross the bugs out as you count. They are tiny and you are less likely to make a mistake if you cross and count.
