Alphabet Activity

Today we are going to do jumping-jacks while we practice saying the alphabet. Each time your child claps his/her hands above his/her head, say a letter.

Phonemic Awareness

Today we are going to play “Back to Back”. Your child needs to have a partner. They stand back to back. You say one of the words below. Each partner needs to sound out the words below with their fingers. They then turn around and check their partners fingers. If they both have the same and correct number of fingers they can give each other a high five. Continue until words are finished.

Place six sight-word cards in a row on the table. The child reads the words and places them face down. Say a word and the child must find it from memory.

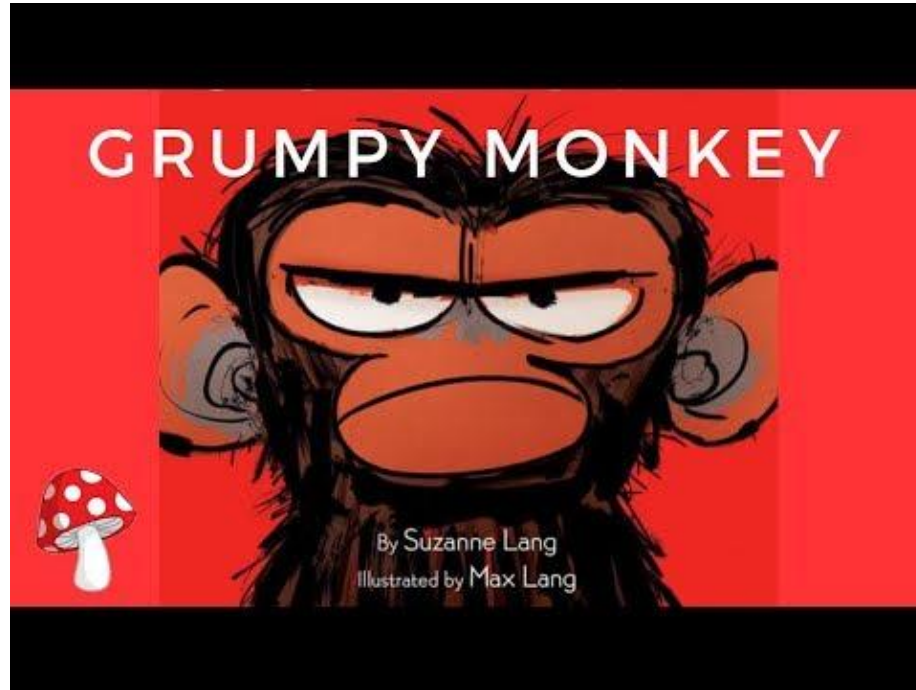
