Alphabet Activity

Today we are going to say the alphabet. Let's skip around in a circle while we say it.

Phonemic Awareness

Have your child get his/her vowel letter tiles out. Remember, the long sound of a vowel is simply the vowel's name. Review the short and long sound of each vowel. You say a word. Have your child look at his/her letter tiles and hold up the letter tile with the vowel you say.

More Phonics

Today we are going to learn the long sound for the letter /ī/. Please listen to the following video. Tell a family member what two sounds the letter /i/ makes when the video is finished. (/ī/ as in ice and /i/ as in inch) The video is not interactive.
