Today we are practicing the sight word “they”. Please print and do the following worksheet.

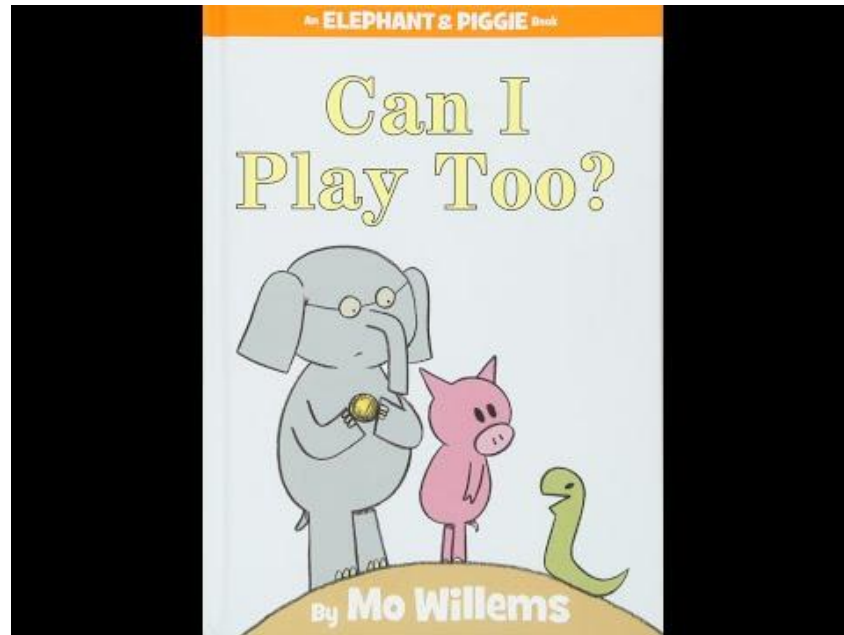
