Today is Insect Day!

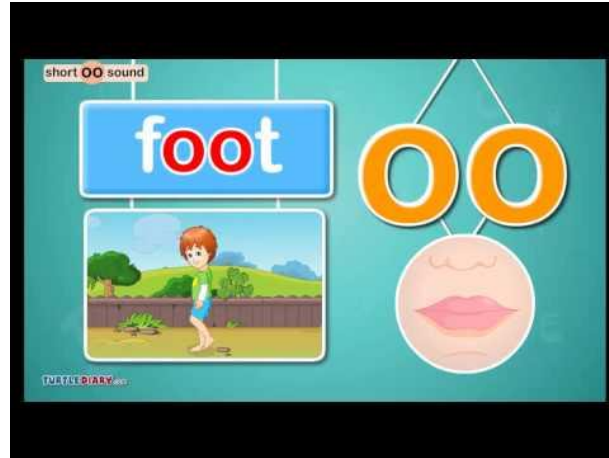
Check out this video on insects,

Phonics

Today we are going to learn about the short “oo” sound as in “hook”

Please watch the following video on “oo”. It is not interactive, however, you could point to the “oo” when asked.



More Phonics

Have your child sound out and write the following words in his/her writing journal or on a piece of paper. Please remember, don't let your child see the word list.

good	wood	brook
stood	cook	foot

Phonemic Awareness

Have your child get their “th” and two blank letter tiles out. If you did not keep the blank ones, just use two small pieces of paper. You are going to say words with three sounds like “than”. Each of the cards will stand for a sound. The cards with the letters “th” will always be used for the “th” sound. The blank cards may be used for any other sounds. Have your child decide where they hear the “th” sound and place the cards in that position. Ex. “than” “th” cards, then the two blank cards.

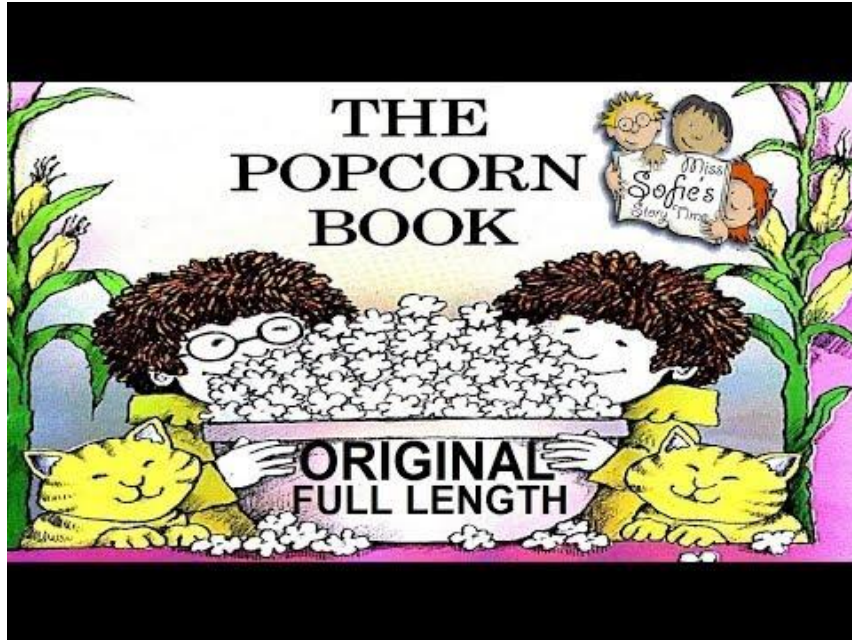

On Spring Subtraction Within 5, subtract the bottom number from the top number in each problem. Write the answer under the line. You could use your fingers or objects like cereal or goldfish to help you subtract.
