Decodable Reader Words

Have your child get out a piece of paper, or use his/her writing journal. You read the following words and have your child sound the words out and write them down. Please don't let them see the list of words.

You can read Look Who Can Cook. This is a small white book we sent home with you.

Phonemic Awareness

Have your child get out two letter /o/ tiles and a /t/, and /h/ tile. If you don't have an extra /o/, use a blank tile and write an /o/ or get a small piece of paper and write one. You say the words below. If the words have an /oo/ sound then have your child hold up the /oo/. If it is the /th/ then hold the /th/ tiles.
