Phonics

Today we are going to practice sounding out and spelling some words that will be in our Decodable Reader “Will She Tell?” Sound out and spell the following words on a piece of paper or in your writing journal.

fish	ship	when
sand	Trish	Josh

More Phonics

Have your child read the Decodable Reader “Will She Tell?”. Discuss the questions at the end.

Phonemic Awareness

You will say part of a word. Your child will add a long vowel sound to the end to make a whole word. Ex: You say: /d/ Child could say /ā/ to make “day” /ī / to make “die”, /ō/ to make “doe” /ū/ to make “dew”.

Repeat with the following sounds. You may not use all the long vowels every time.

/h/

/j/

/n/

/sh/

Math Assignment

Today we will do “**Greater Than, Less Than or Equal**” and “**Comparing Numbers**”.

On Greater Than, Less Than or Equal cross and count each ten frame. Color the ones that are greater red, and the ones that are less blue. If they are equal, color them yellow.

On Comparing Numbers, cut the symbols off the sides. Look at the numbers in the box, decide which one is greater or less than and glue on the correct symbol. Remember the open side or the big side is the side that opens to the biggest number. The small side points to the smallest number.
