Alphabet Activity

Today we are going to say the alphabet. Let's march as we say it.
Put one foot down for each letter of the alphabet you say.

Phonemic Awareness

Have your child get his/her “c, k, h, and s” letter tiles out. You say a word. Have your child look at his/her letter tiles and hold up the letter tiles with the correct digraph. (ck, or sh)

fresh	snack	swish
wreck	shoulder	shower

More Phonics

Today we are going to learn the long sound for the letter /ō/. Please listen to the following video. Tell a family member what two sounds the letter /o/ makes when the video is finished. (/ō/ as in oak and /o/ as in hop) The video is not interactive.
