Phonics

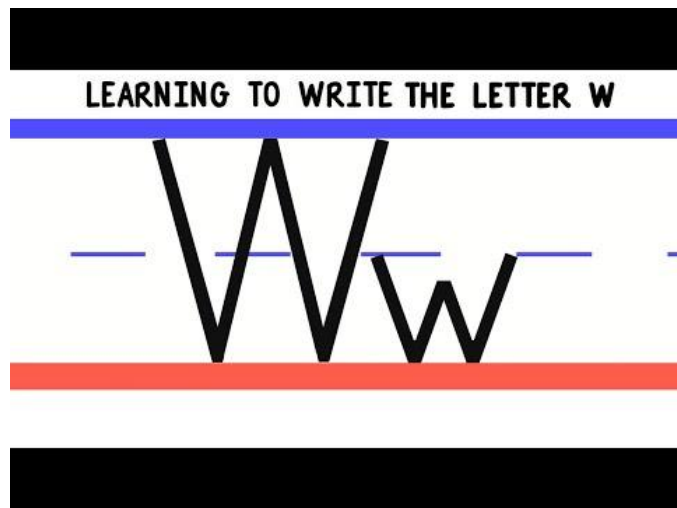
What were some of the things that begin with the sound /w/? Draw and label 3 things that begin with letter w on a piece of paper. (You could draw them in your ABC book if you would like)

Phonics

Tell your child you are going to say part of a word. Have them add the /w/ sound to the beginning to make a whole word.

Ex. You say /ax/. Have your child say /w/ then have your child say /wax/ and put those two sounds together to say /wax/.

ind (wind)	ay (way)	ade (wade)
altz (waltz)	et (wet)	all (wall)
ood (wood)	agon (wagon)	ait (wait)

Start your sentence like this:

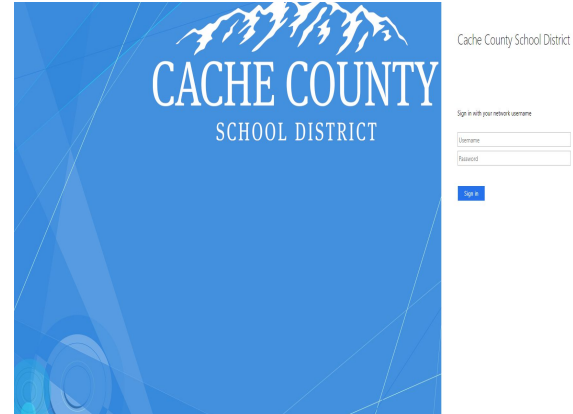
“I would plant...”
