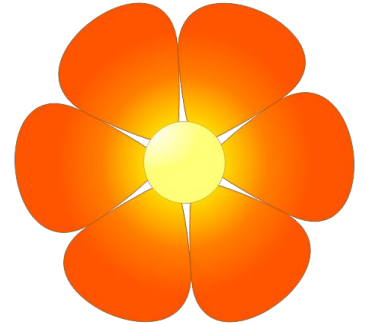
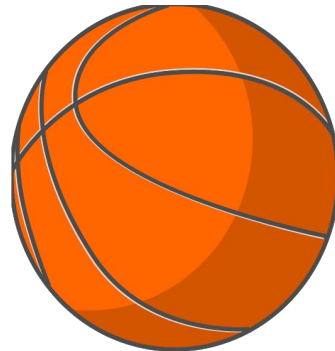

Sight Word Memory

Place six sight-word cards in a row on the table. Have your child read the words and place them face down. You say a word and your child must find it from memory.

Guess the Word

Draw 4 lines on a dry erase board (or piece of paper) _ _ _ _ and place 10 letter tiles (including the letters in the word) at the top. Ask your child to choose a sound. If that sound is in the word, place it on the correct line. If the sound is not in the word, take a token (or some other object) from a stuffed animal sitting nearby. The child tries to figure out the word before the animal loses all of his tokens! Remember, please don't let your child see the word list.

On I Can Count to 100 cut the picture stripes of the bottom of the page, then cut them apart. Put the numbers in order counting by tens. Glue them on the page. Then you can color the picture.
