Review and Approval of Minutes

Clarification of last month's minutes: I Love You Guys is a website. Parents can go to the website iloveyouguys.org to learn more. Teachers get a monthly explanation for drills, including child-friendly videos to teach children.

Sara motioned to approve the last monthly minutes and Amber seconded the motion. Vote taken and approved unanimously.

Budget review

Trust lands% remaining = 45.54%

TSSA % remaining = 31.61

New business:

1. Our lock down drill was very successful! There were 4 substitutes the day of the drill, and everything was explained to them by Nikki Petersen, our safety chair.
2. Before next year, we need to dive into the safe walking routes map. There are new neighborhoods of growth not even on the map. We may need to have a group actually walk the routes to figure this out.
3. Magnet school discussion
 - a. We don't know the outcome of the surveys yet.
 - b. Many Sunrise parents are opposed
4. Attendance data: 129 students are missing 10% or more days
 - a. 17% of our students are chronically absent
 - b. 1st grade 17%
 - c. 2nd grade 19%
 - d. 3rd grade 14%
 - e. 4th grade 14%
 - f. 5th grade 13%
 - g. 6th grade 16%

5. Kindergarten registration
 - a. Consider signage out on main street to get more parent to register their children in advance

6. School Land Trust and TSSA info
 - a. Reviewed last year's final report and goals
 - i. Shellie clarified our reading goals from last year and the scores of each grade.
 - b. Discussed our new upcoming plan for the 2024-2025 school year School Land Trust
 - i. Reading goal
 1. K-2: The number of students proficient will increase by 10% (on or above benchmark)
 2. 3-6: 75% of students will make "typical" or "above typical" progress on the Acadience Pathway report.
 3. Shellie explained the "action steps" which will be taken to achieve our goals.
 - a. Allocating funds as salaries and PD for Paraprofessionals. To work with small reading groups
 - b. Using grade level PLC's
 - c. Grade Level meetings
 - d. All certified teachers will have one day to study the new ELA program (Wonders) which will be adopted for next year. The funding will provide for substitutes to allow teachers to collaborate.
