Reports:

Digital Citizenship

Katelyn Ballif presented the digital citizenship curriculum to council members. This includes: Privacy and Security, Digital Footprint, Cyberbullying, and News and Media. If there is time after these, Media Balance and Relationships and Communication are also taught. Kindergarten students are only required to learn Privacy and Security. Katelyn offered to prepare an information sheet for parents if council members would like her to send something home.

Acadience and Math Data

The data on Acadience and Math are available, however, because the reports are in a new format; the test results cannot be shared right now without divulging the names of children. Derek is working on finding a solution.

Summer suggested that data representing subgroups of students be shared (such as those who were home last year, or other diversity factors that the council might want to attend to.)

Home School

More money is available this year to support students who didn't attend public school last year in order to serve those in need of extra help.

Crosswalks/Sidewalks on 300 South

The City still plans to put a crosswalk in on 10th East and 3rd South

A concern of no sidewalk availability on 300 south and 370 East east because of construction was brought up. It is believed the problem has been taken care of for now.
