## Review and Approval of Minutes

No meetings in March or April

Brooke moved to approve the last monthly minutes and seconded by Launa.

## Current School Plan Funding

Shellie reviewed the Trust Land and TSSA budgets

1. Trust Lands Funding for 2022-23 \$114,285  
(Paras 56,892 Supplies \$899 Technology \$39,816 Software \$12,200)  
Goal 1 - READING  
80% proficiency on middle-of-year acadience.  
90% of students will be at/approaching or above level by mid-year on the Growth Measure  
Goal 2 - MATH  
55% of students will be on grade level at the MOY iReady diagnostic results in Feb.(22-23 BOY 26%)  
74% of 1st-6th by MOY assessment. Acadience Math (K-3) last year's data showed 70% of our students were proficient by the MOY.
2. TSSA Funding for 2022-23 \$136,307 (support the Academic Goals listed above)  
(Counselor \$17,000 TVs & iPads \$35,307 Paras \$76,581 Health Aide \$4,853)  
Goal 1 Mental health, social skills, PBIS (half of a full time counselor wage)  
Goal 2 Replace short throws with TVs and iPads  
Goal 3 Paras in SpEd, large classes, behavior, and academic support  
Goal 4 Health aide additional hour and 20 minutes

Discussion about adding writing as a goal:

- Brooke brought up concern about writing instruction.
- Kathy seems to think there are not enough minutes dedicated to writing instruction.
- Jake Downs is in charge of district writing samples which are used as a tool to determine writing lesson plans and student progress - the skills are being taught but do not seem to be retained. We should focus more on writing as a school.

## New Business

We discussed new members and discuss results of candidate interest form

- Korry, Rachel, and Summer have completed their 2 year commitment on the council.
- Need 3 more parents - Shellie will send out parent interest forms. We received one candidate from Back to School night.
- They will be due on the 7th. If we get more than 3 interested we will need to hold an election.

We decided on monthly meeting dates and times and committee roles

- Nikkala will be the Chairperson
- Brooke will be Co-Chair
- Launa will be secretary
- Shellie will send minutes to Nikkala for review a week in advance and she will send reminders to the council. Shellie will post them on the website.
- Decision was made to continue with the 7:30 am meetings on the LAST Tuesday of the month.

We had an Open Discussion

- Sidewalks need to be cut along 455 east to allow bikes and wheelchairs to stay on the sidewalk
- Shellie will talk to the city and look at the grant from Safe Routes Utah
- Mandatory SCC district training on October 4th 6:00-6:30 - Shellie will send us the link.
- New buzz-in system for school security - show ID if Caron doesn't know them - Tim Smith and Gary Thomas are making a podcast to explain the new system for parents - small things like having to stop and announce yourself could deflate a potential problem or irrational adult - situation last week where a parent was in a classroom waiting and teacher didn't know she was in there - need to be more diligent about telling parents to check in at the office and wear a visitor tag - Nikkala concerned that the buzz-in system is deterring the wrong people from coming into the school - she feels it is making parents feel unwelcome
- Cameras - 3 more will be added this year
- New drinking fountain with bottle filler
- Water pooling by recess doors is a slip and fall hazard and will be repaired over fall break weather permitting
