

Where Are We At?

2018-2019 District Data Story Highlights

As a district we owe a tremendous thanks to the parents of students in our schools. There is a tremendous feeling of support that is evidenced by the wonderful students who attend school each day. The Cache County School District is staffed with incredible, caring staffs who each day strive to help students be safe and to learn at a high level.

One of the goals of education of the Cache County School District is to have as many students possible graduate from high school and to have these students demonstrate college and career readiness skills. The District Data Story 2018-2019 attempts to examine the learning of these students through examining student learning data. No story is 100% accurate. The data included in this district story represents one day in a student's life. Also, data is only useful if it is compared to something. Within this data story, Cache student learning data is compared to the nation, where possible, to state averages, and against other schools in our district. It is hopeful when examining this data story that a person would identify both strengths and weaknesses of the learning in our district. Data should generate questions. Each school should be able to answer all the why? And then, the What? questions generated by this story. Hal Urban taught us that, "Experts are among us." This expertise is found within a team of teachers and administrators who are not content to tell their learning story in vague terms, but who are only satisfied when they are able to put a name and a face to the data. These teachers should dive so deeply into learning data that they discover the story behind each student who is not proficient, be able to identify the essential skill(s) each of these students are missing. Next, this school level team must create a plan to help intervene and remediate these students. They must combine formative data to more fully come to understand the learning needs of each student. Schools must work within the professional learning community/RTI process to provide excellent Tier I instruction where over 90% of the students are proficient and then allow Tier II and Tier III intervention procedures to help each student learn at a high level. It is important that schools only worry about those school level factors that they control. Students that struggle to become proficient need additional time during the school day and additional expert support and instruction.

It is our hope that the District Data Story is used to begin these conversations within our district. Please remember to celebrate all the good things that happen. This is perhaps more important than just pointing out the things that did not happen.

Cache County School District Assessment Section (Robyn Hedgecock and Blake Pickett)

2018-2019 District Data Story Highlights

Graduation Rate (2018)

The Cache County School District has a 95% graduation rate which is second highest in the state. Cache High school had a graduation rate of 89% above the state graduation rate of 87%. All four other high schools are above the state graduation rate.

2019 Graduating Class ACT

The Cache District's Composite score (20.7) is above the state composite score (20.3) and equal to the national composite score (20.7). In mathematics and reading the district scores are above or equal to the state and national scores.

Thirty-two percent of Cache student met all four ACT Benchmark readiness standards compared to 24% for the state of Utah. More students (66%) in our district met the English College and Career Readiness standard than in math, reading or science.

2019 ACT Grade 11

The district exceeded the state composite benchmark by a score of 20.6 to 19.7. Green Canyon, Mountain Crest, and Ridgeline each exceeded the state average composite score.

The district scored higher than the state in the mathematics, science, and the composite scores.

Advanced Placement

The average passing rate for all students who tool AP exams was 67.3%. This ranks 8th in the state with districts who gave 100 exams or more. Utah ranks 7th in the nation and 1st in the Western United States in advanced placement scores. Ridgeline high school students took more advanced placement exams (266) than any other high school in our district.

Concurrent Enrollment

Students in the Cache school district earned 13,089 concurrent enrollment credits with Sky View students earning the most (3,938) in our district. More credits were earned in English 1010 and Psychology 1010 than other concurrent classes.

Utah Aspire Plus 9th and 10th Grade Students

Both 9th and 10th grade students scored higher than the state average in ELA, math, and science in percent proficient. All four high schools were above the state average for the Language Arts, math, and science assessments in percent proficient. In LA, math. Several schools scored significantly above the state average in percent proficient.


RISE Grades 3-6


ACT Graduating Class 2019 3 Year Trend




