Background: The Utah State Board of Education has established a Seal of Biliteracy. The following was adopted by the Board of Education:

The USBE's Seal of Biliteracy certifies attainment of a high level of proficiency by a graduating high school student in one or more languages in addition to English, and certifies that the graduate meets all of the following criteria:

- 1. The UBSE's Seal of Biliteracy will be awarded to students who earn a Utah high school diploma and be proficient in English and at least one world language other than English, at the intermediate-mid level or higher, as demonstrated through an assessment from a list to be approved by the Superintendent of Public Instruction.
- 2.For the purpose of this form, "world language" means a language other than English and includes American Sign Language and American Native Languages (Navajo, Ute, etc.)

Directions to Applicants:

- 1. Complete all sections of the application. Type or print legibly all information.
- 2. Submit application and documentation of qualifying scores to your school counselor at your high school beginning October 1 but **no later than May 1**. If May 1 falls on a weekend, then the following Monday.
- 3. If you will not have assessment results until after the application due date, write "pending results" in the score box.
