Only staff ANNUALLY trained by A CCSD Nurse can provide the following procedure

ALWAYS FOLLOW THE STUDENT'S INDIVIDUALIZED HEALTH CARE PLAN

PROTOCOL A. Preparation: Identify student's ability to participate in procedure Review universal precautions Identify where procedure is done – restroom with privacy Completes catheterization on time Position student for catheterization as per student's IHP Identifies vesicostomy site Identifies possible problems and appropriate actions B. Identifies supplies and gathers equipment 1. Lubricant (water soluble), Straight catheter, Wet Wipes, Cleansing supplies, Storage receptacle for used catheter, Container for urine, Gloves C. Procedure 1. Wipe off area where procedure is performed 2. Arranges equipment for procedure 3. Positions student and explains procedure 4. Wash hands and puts on gloves 5. Lubricates catheter and places on clean surface 6. Cleans: Cleans vesicostomy site- cleanest to dirtiest 7. Grasps catheter about 3 inches from tip, inserts into site until urine begins to flow, Advances ½ inch more 8. Allow urine to flow by gravity into toilet or cup 9. Rotates catheter so all catheter openings reach all bladder areas, 10. If ordered, gently press bladder to help empty 11. Stops and waits until all urine has drained if urine begins to flow again during removal 12. Pinches catheter and withdraws slowly when urine stops flowing, Discard catheter appropriately 13. Cleans equipment, allow to dry and store in clean container 14. Remove gloves and washes hands 15. Assist student in dressing
