**Follow Up**

Parking Lot Sidewalk Safety

After observing the crosswalk running through the entrance to the school parking lot/pick up area for a few months, council members brought out the following safety concerns:

Surveillance Camera's Installed

## **New Business**

### Tri School Fundraiser

The Tri School Golf Tournament Fundraiser is coming up in May. Community Council members help with this each year by spreading the word to friends and businesses in an effort to recruit teams and sponsors. The school earns around 5,000 each year from this event.

### Dual Language Lottery

The dual language lottery will be held this Thursday (20<sup>th</sup>). One parent is needed to attend. Becky Greenwood volunteered to sit in on the lottery.

### Planning for Trust Lands Money

Council Members were asked to start thinking about ways to utilize the Trust Lands Money. There are two main goals; reading and math. This year there was a heavy focus on aides to support those areas. Aides have been helpful in early reading intervention, reiterating math concepts, etc. Growth has been seen as a result of the aides.

Current Reading and Math data sheets were shared with Council Members. The plan is to look at all the data available to see where the weak points are in order to maximize the benefits of money spent.
