School Land Trust Goals

He discussed current goals and explained that some of the goals set last year on the School Land Trust Goals has a potential of being harder to reach because of the school shut down" last spring, because students may be below where they should be, going into this year.

Because the end of year assessment (RISE) might not be administered, council members might need to look at finding different ways to write goals, using possible other ways of measurement.

School Plan Expenditures

Currently, money has been spent on aids, chrome books, teacher computers and software. Any money left over from other sources, will go towards technology. Starting next year, old chrome labs will start needing replacement. Other needs; upgrading sound systems, projectors and document cameras.
