School Safety

After School Pickup

The PTA has arranged for one parent, every other month, for two days, to set up cones by the street corners and remind parents to not park there while picking up their children. Review of school community council training

New Business

Physical Safety of the School

Throughout the day, there is a single point access to enter the building. Just the front doors are open after the bell rings in the morning.

Cameras have been purchased and are waiting to be installed. There will be six cameras outside of the building as well as some on the inside. Cameras can be added to the system as needed.

The entrance to the school needs to be remodeled to improve on safety.

Possible money could come from LAND Trust money and/or the school district.

The school uses the DIRs system to help keep children safe in a possible threat.

The different drills are; lock down, hall check, shelter in place and evacuation.

Drills are practiced monthly.
