 - Certain photos are considered to be child pornography.
 - Common sense practices to advise students and parents to be aware.
 - Some advice and rules to follow for parents and students:
 - Parents monitor your child's emails, usernames, and passwords.
 - No phones in bedrooms alone.
 - Do not expose yourself in a photo ever.
 - Parents set up and use parental controls.
 - Parents gather devices at night.
