 - State Report Card data
 - Blair discussed the attached charts and went over the information
 - Achievement scores are from both 7th and 8th grades
 - The school saw an increase in Math and English. A 0.1 % decrease in science was seen, however science score was much higher than state or district avg.
 - For growth scores average growth is 50% and all test for Spring Creek are higher than that.
 - Growth scores are based on how students do compared to the previous year.
 - Growth in the lowest 25% of students was 74.9 last year
 - For the English Learners, the reaching proficiency score is new this year. These in addition to the WETA are used to measure aptitude.
