School Items:

Explanation of Registration Process (Matt Southam - Counselor)

Matt gave an overview of the registration process. Registration will begin for the outgoing 8th graders with Green Canyon and Ridgeline High School Counselors coming to Spring Creek, Feb. 6th, helping with a step by step registration form completion.

Current 7th graders will complete their registration for the upcoming school year with help from the counseling department starting Feb. 8th. They are able to choose 3-4 electives, and will help them step by step. Matt shared how when registering students and determining schedules there are several different considerations, balancing out by classes, as well as accommodations that might be needed. For any students that are absent, the counselors will do a follow up to complete each individual student's registration.

In early March they will reach out to the 6th grade elementary feeder schools to start registering the incoming 7th graders with similar procedures.

There will be an email sent out to parents to notify them of upcoming registrations.

Trustlands:

Greatest Needs

Blair Powell expressed a need for funding a Parent/Liaison as well as Project Aware for next year. The current funding or grants are expiring (sunset clause). We will need to decide whether to fund through Trustlands. The approximate amount needed is between \$50,000 - \$60,000.

State School Report Card Data:

This was discussed at the last meeting. Went over the data which reflects positive growth. The Literacy Department is going to be implementing something new. Math & English are strong, Science score

decreased slightly, however the science score was much higher than state or district avg. The intervention program seems to be working well, which we will continue to fund.
