8th graders going into High School have registered. If your student missed it or if you have any questions, contact the counseling department.

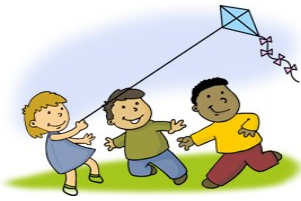
7th graders going into 8th grade will be registering the week of March 20th.
