

Minutes for School Community Council meeting dated 01/13/2016.

Attendees: Jeremy Wiley, Carmen Sorenson, Stephanie Swainston, Terry Williams, Max Jones, Wendee Radmall, Teri Rhodes, Shawn Anderson

Minutes from our previous meeting were approved unanimously.

Jim Schaub was selected as this year's Teacher of the Year. Jim teaches Guitar and Orchestra. Teacher of the year is selected through nominations by students, colleagues, and parents. Jim will be recognized at the school board Thursday, January 21.

Students and Parents are currently being invited to take a stakeholder survey of teachers at North Cache. Parents were emailed a link to the survey, and students were invited to take the survey during Homeroom this past Monday. The survey is open until January 15. Teachers will be provided with the results of the survey. 10% of teacher evaluation will come from how teachers reflect on and use the survey results. Jeremy Wiley, who received the email earlier this month, brought up some concern that the instructions were vague. He was not sure which teachers he was supposed to survey, and several of the other parents agreed. Teri Rhodes mentioned that the same concern was brought up in a recent board meeting.

Each school district in Utah is required to report to each School Community Council how the school is teaching and ensuring digital safety and digital citizenship. Principal Williams spent the rest of the meeting informing the members about what actions North Cache takes for digital safety and citizenship. North Cache has several computer labs and mobile chromebook labs that students have access to. Before students are allowed to use these, they and their parents are required to sign an Appropriate Use Policy. If students violate this policy, they lose access to the internet at school. They will be allowed to access the internet for major tests, such as SAGE, but only under strict adult supervision. Teachers sign a similar policy at the beginning of each school year. North Cache bring Netsmartz in each year to present to students about digital safety and citizenship.
