Minutes for School Community Council meeting dated 09/10/2015.

Election for Chair and Vice-Chair will happen at next month's meeting when there is a higher attendance. Stephanie Swainston was elected as Secretary.

A motion was made for the School Community Counsel to also act as the Advisory Committee for the Counseling Program at North Cache. As an Advisory Committee for the Counseling Program, members discuss needs they see in the school and community and suggest ideas to address those needs. The counselors use these suggestions and results from the SHARP survey to determine what to focus on with students throughout the year. Bullying, especially cyberbullying, has been a big focus the last couple years. The Advisory Committee will help organize lunch activities in which students have the opportunity to listen to a guest speaker. This guest speaker will talk about their career and what education was required to get into that career. The counseling department will also chose a college in the state of Utah to focus on each month. The Advisory Committee can provide information about the various colleges. The committee will be able to provide feedback about the activities the counselors lead.

The motion for the School Community Counsel to act as the Advisory Committee for the Counseling Program at North Cache was approved.

An official training will be help at Spring Creek on Wednesday, Oct. 21, from 6-8 pm. School Community Council members are invited and encouraged to attend.

\$1500 of the School Trust Land Fund is set aside for Fight the New Drug. Max Jones and Terry Williams will work on getting this scheduled as quickly as possible.

One of the goals of the Trust Land Plan is a 2% increase on SAGE scores from last year to this year. Last year's (2014-2015) scores show a 6% increase in Math, 3% increase in English, and 3% increase in Science. We want to continue that improvement.

Attendees watched "A Matter of Trust". This video explains where the funding comes from, roles of council members, and appropriate goals and use of the Trust Land Fund.

Next month's meeting agenda will include elections of a Chair and Vice-Chair, a closer look at the Trust Land Plan, and a review of data from SAGE, CTE, and AMP (Adult Mentor Program).
