Utah Public Schools List of Needed Registration and Proof of Residency Documents

Before a student is enrolled in a Utah public school, the student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must show proof of Utah residency in the school district in which the student desires to enroll.

- This residency procedure does not apply to homeless students as defined in the McKinney/Vento Act
- If you are open enrolled, bring you Open Enrollment approval letter as proof of address to the school.

All applicants must submit a Birth Certificate and an Immunization Record along with at

least one document from each of the following columns:
