


A Little About Meadow Green

- Create clear rules and rewards and have consequences for undesired behavior.
- Be a parent, not a friend of your child.
- Ask questions regarding academics.
- Seek our assistance and support as well. We are in this together for one reason: Academic and social success now and in the future.

Be Aware of All Areas of Your Child's Development

- Set homework time for success.
- Have breaks in between homework and the end of school.
- Structured activities are great, but be careful not to overload.
- Set them up for success different from your success as a child.

- Always compliment and reward hard work even though the reward is small.
- Have fun outside of homework and school.
- Be aware of friendships.
