President Schambeck shared that Army Staff Sergeant Ryan M. Pitts was being honored at the White House today as the nation’s newest Medal of Honor recipient. Staff Sergeant Pitts is the sole survivor of an attack that left nine soldiers dead in Afghanistan as 200 Taliban militants attacked their post.
