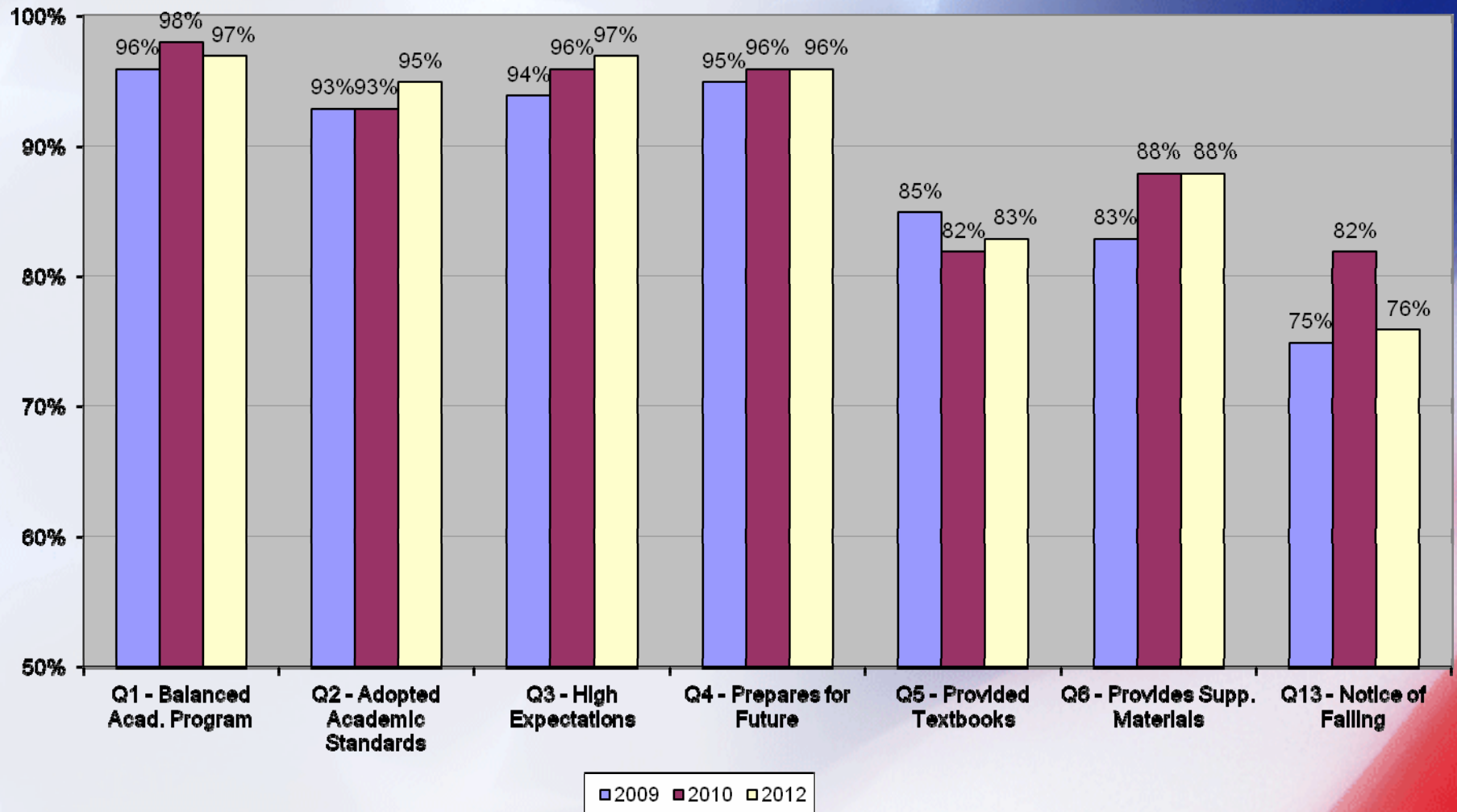

Question Number:

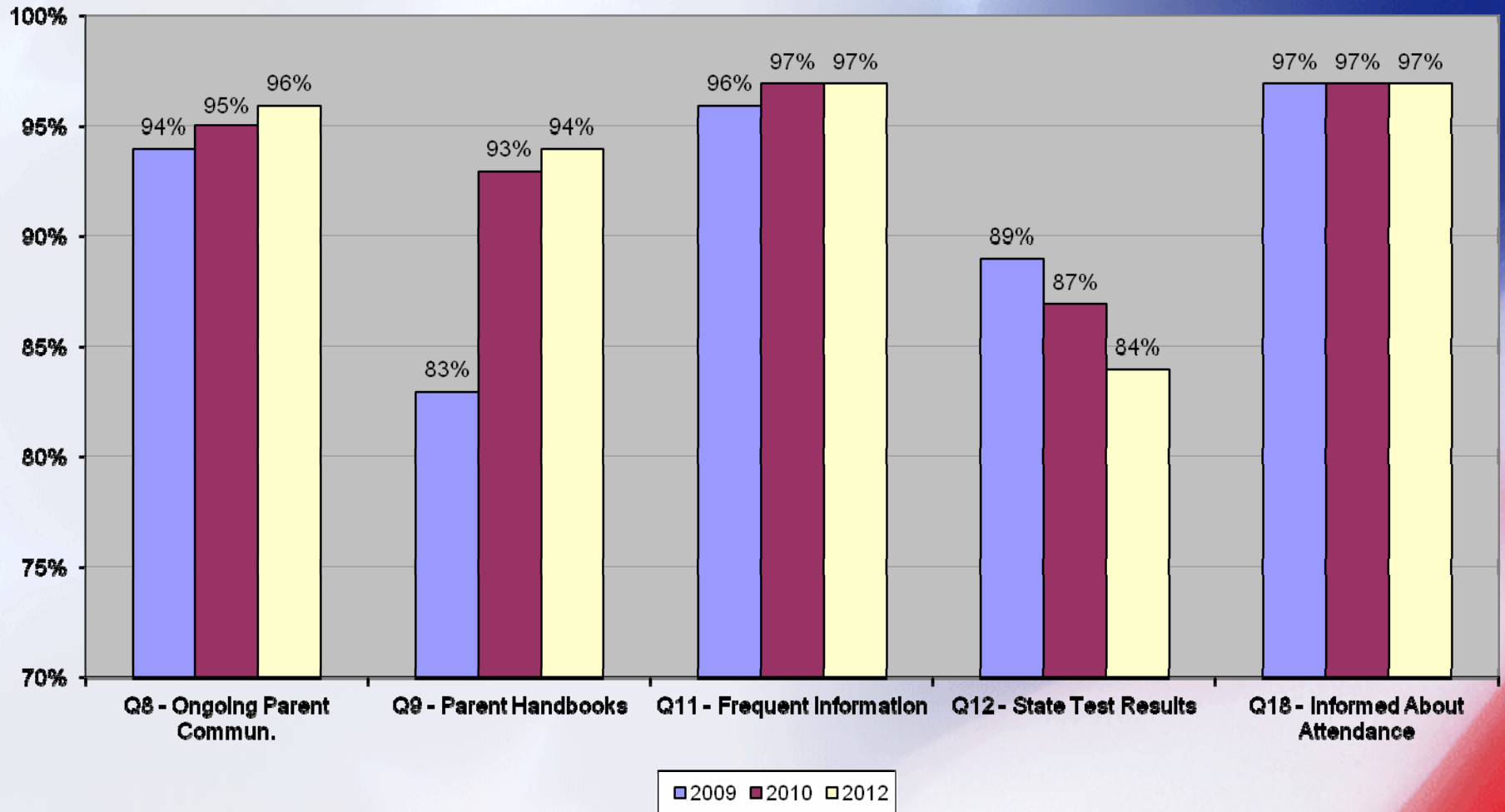


# Parent Communication

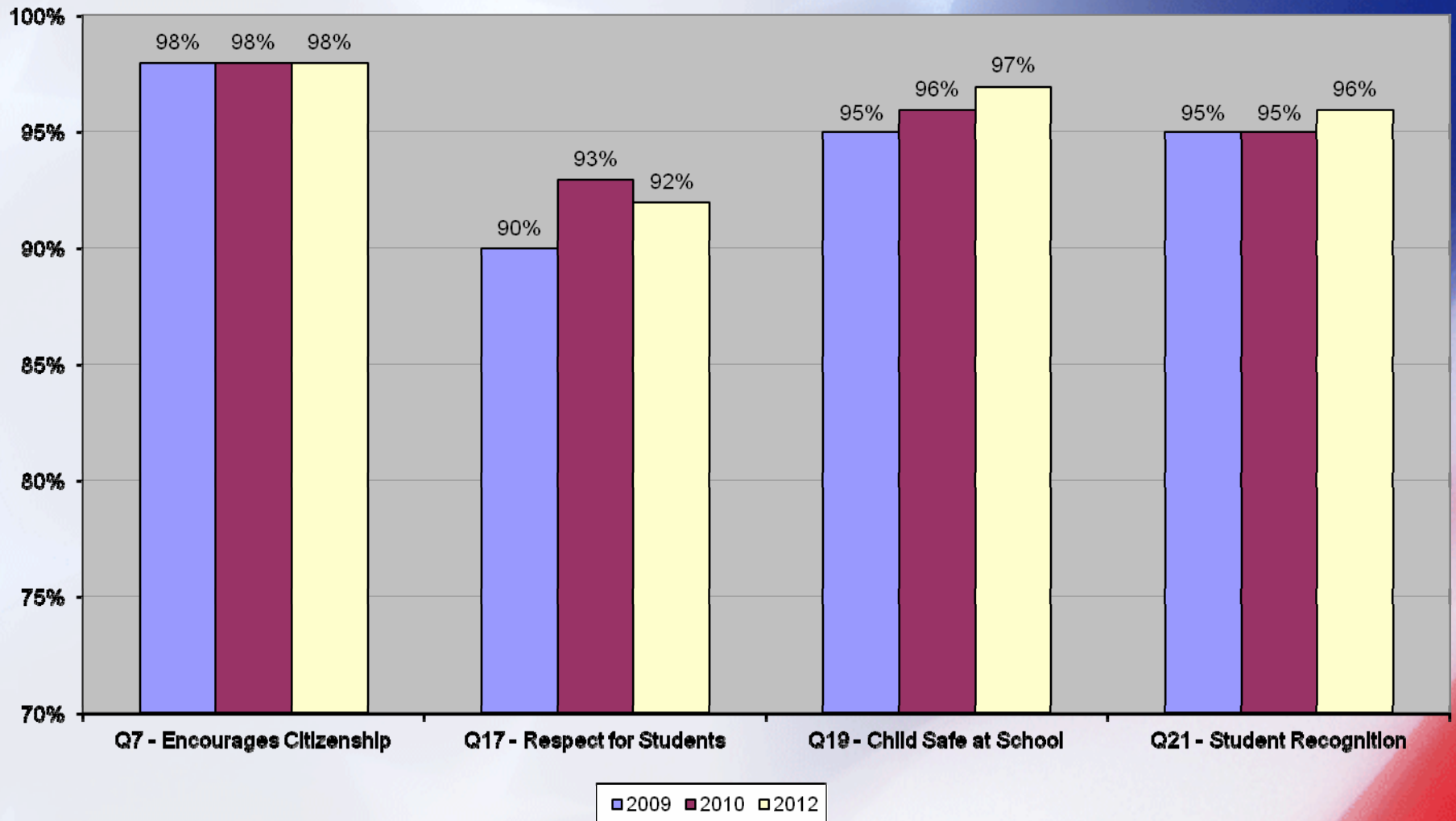

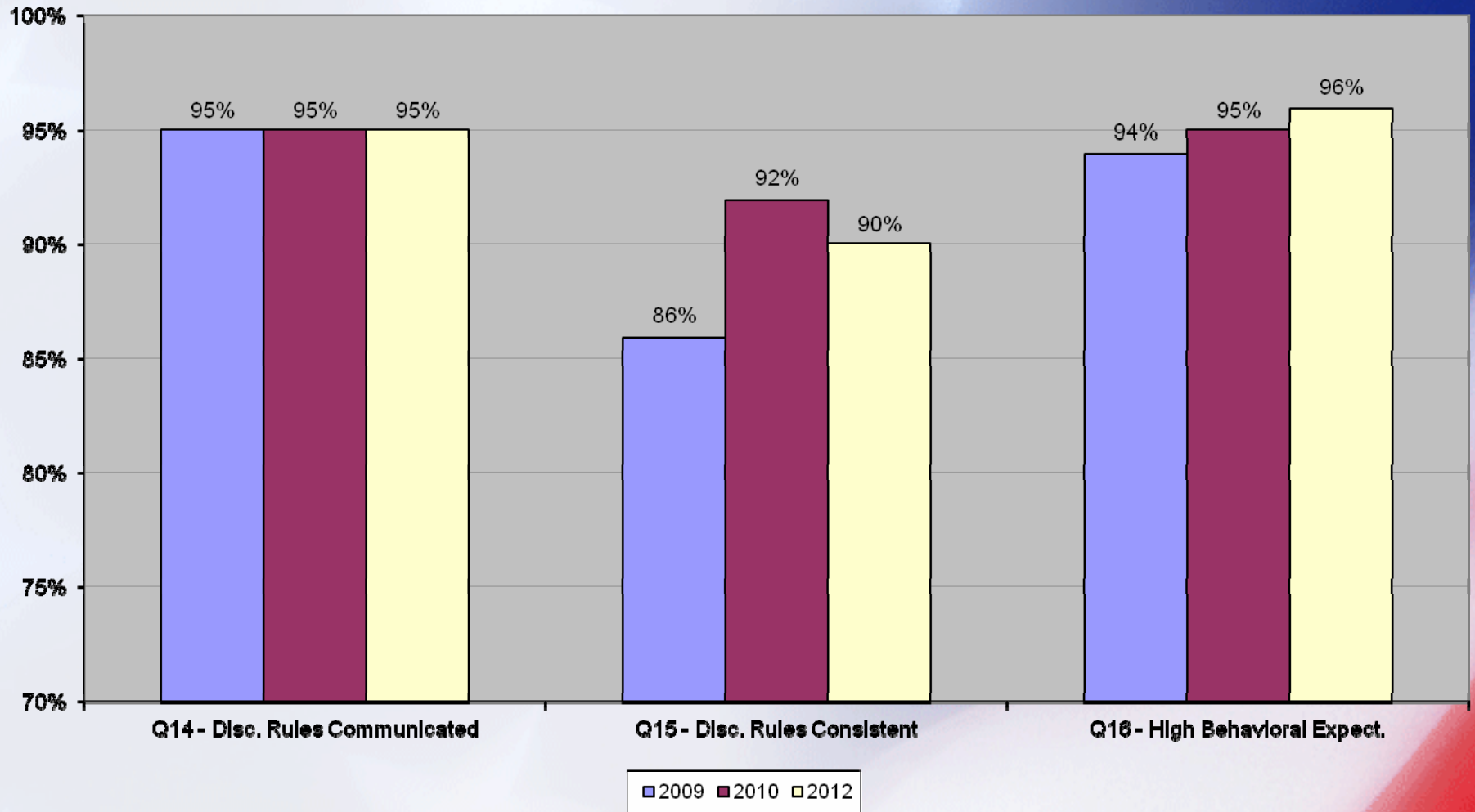


# Student Behavior

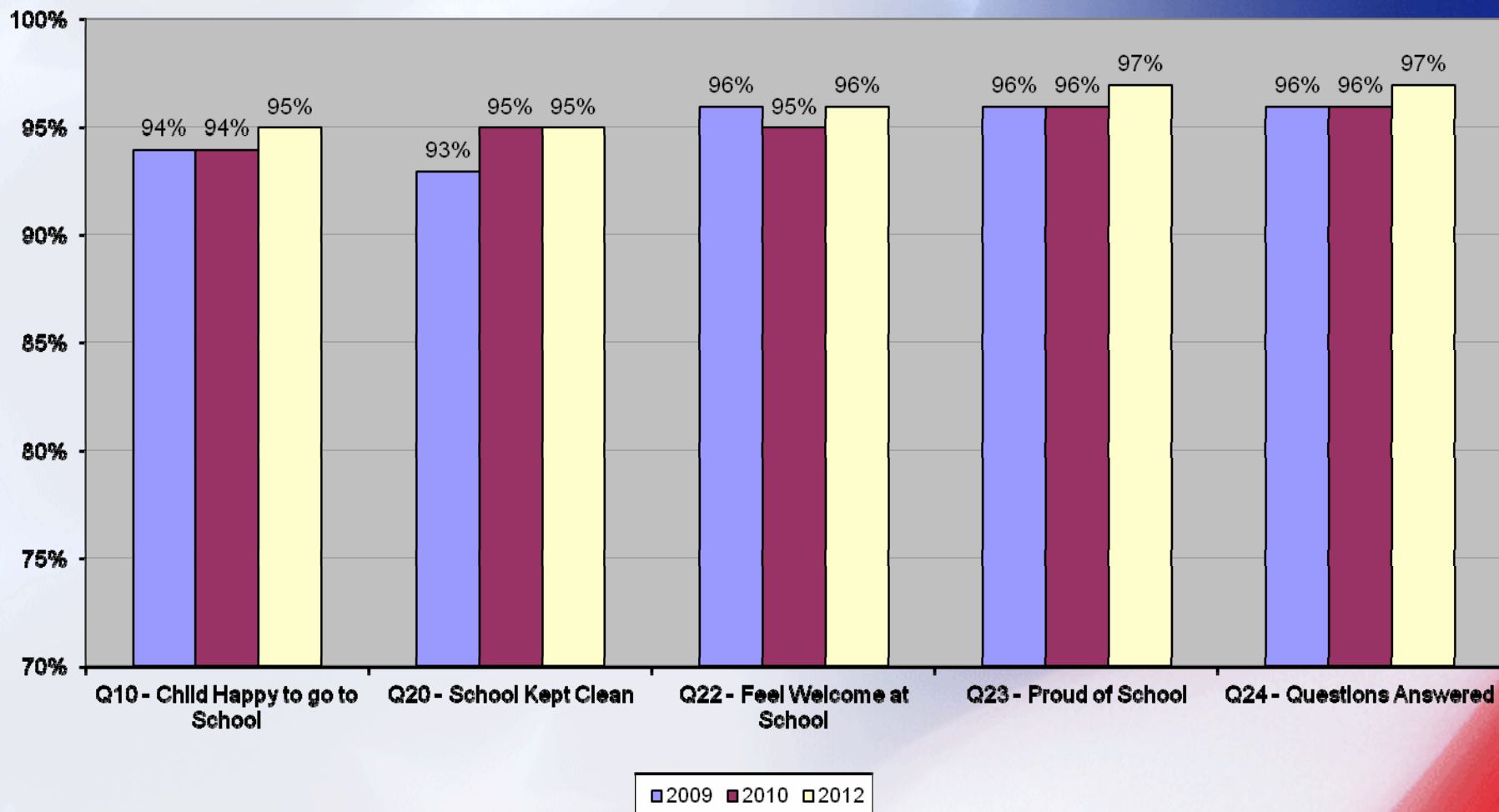
