Academic Programs

- ★ All schools received an 862 or above on the Academic Performance Index
- ★ Rancho-Starbuck Intermediate was honored as a California Distinguished School
- ★ The District achieved higher at every grade level in ELA and Math than Orange County, Los Angeles County, and the State on the CST tests

Academic Programs

- ★ Implemented the Common Core Standards in Kindergarten and first grade and trained second, third, seventh, and eighth grade teachers
- ★ Continued emphasis on the use of Explicit Direct Instruction (EDI) classroom instructional strategies and provided EDI Coaches at each of the sites
- ★ All schools offered before-school and/or after-school academic intervention classes

Academic Programs

- ★ Implemented the *Illuminate* system to assist teachers with data analysis and report cards and provided a Data Coach at each site
- ★ Assemblies focusing on bullying were provided at all six schools
- ★ Continued to implement Step-Up-To-Writing as the District writing program at all sites
- ★ Continued to utilize the *MIND Institute ST Math Program* at all six schools
- ★ Provided *Ticket to Read*, *Lexia*, and *DyNed* reading programs at the elementary schools

Academic Programs

- ★ Provided professional development training for teachers, classified staff members, and administrators
- ★ Provided before- and after-school childcare program at Jordan, Macy and Meadow Green Elementary Schools
- ★ Continued to provide character education and patriotic emphasis
- ★ Working with the Lowell Joint Education Foundation, offered after-school sports at Rancho-Starbuck Intermediate School and hosted Academic Excellence Day

Technology

- ★ Updated the District's website and websites for each of the schools
- ★ Installed new computers and upgraded software at all of the school sites
- ★ Installed fiber optics from the District Office to each of the school sites to increase the bandwidth capabilities

Nutrition Services

- ★ Added new healthy meal choices, including a wider variety of fresh fruits and vegetables for student lunches
- ★ Nutrition Services served 226,074 lunches and 77,366 Grab & Go/Breakfast meals, ending the fiscal year with a positive budget balance for the fourth consecutive year

Maintenance of Facilities

- ★ Repainted and recarpeted interiors of classrooms throughout the District
- ★ Completed over 2,000 work-order requests throughout the District in order to address safety issues and improve cleanliness in the classrooms and restrooms
- ★ Painted the outside of classroom buildings and classroom interiors as needed
