

- My school notifies me in a timely manner if my student is at risk of failing.


#### Lowell Joint School District Parent Survey Historical Results Percentage of Answers Indicating Agree "Academic Preparation"

- 18. I am adequately informed about my son's/daughter's attendance.


#### Lowell Joint School District Parent Survey Historical Results Percentage of Answers Indicating Agree "Parent Communication"

- 21. My child's school provides adequate recognition of student success.


#### Lowell Joint School District Parent Survey Historical Results Percentage of Answers Indicating Agree "School Environment"

- 16. Staff members have high behavioral expectations for my child.


Lowell Joint School District Parent Survey Historical Results Percentage of Answers Indicating Agree "Student Behavior"
