Survey Results


Organized into five categories:

Academic Preparation

- My child's school offers a balanced academic program including reading, language arts, math, social studies, and science.
- 2. My child's school has adopted academic content standards in reading, language arts, math, social studies, and science as required by the State.
- 3. Teachers have high expectations for my child's learning.
- 4. The school prepares my child for his/her future learning.
- 5. My child is provided a textbook in all subjects.
- 6. My child's school provides supplemental materials including reading and language workbooks, math materials, flash cards, games, etc.
- 13. My school notifies me in a timely manner if my student is at risk of failing.

Lowell Joint School District Parent Survey Historical Results Percentage of Answers Indicating Agree "Academic Preparation"



- 18. I am adequately informed about my son's/daughter's attendance.


Lowell Joint School District Parent Survey Historical Results Percentage of Answers Indicating Agree "Parent Communication"

- 21. My child's school provides adequate recognition of student success.


Lowell Joint School District Parent Survey Historical Results Percentage of Answers Indicating Agree "School Environment"

- 16. Staff members have high behavioral expectations for my child.


Lowell Joint School District Parent Survey Historical Results Percentage of Answers Indicating Agree "Student Behavior"
